Slow-No-Wake Area
Lake Sinissippi

A Sole Ordinance To Regulate Boating Upon The Waters Of Lake Sinissippi And Prescribing The Penalties For Violations Thereof.

The Lake Sinissippi Improvement District Board in Dodge County in the town of Hubbard, WI do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Applicability and Enforcement

- a) The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Lake Sinissippi.
- b) The provisions of the ordinance shall be enforced by the Wardens of the DNR.

Section 2: Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment and protection of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and the capability of water resources.

Section 3: State Boating and Safety Law Adopted

The ordinance is adopted by the authority of the State of Wisconsin through Wisconsin Stats... 30-50 to 30-71 reference.

Section 4: Definitions

- a) Slow-No-Wake means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while maintaining steerage control.
- b) Buoys are floating markers that clearly identify Slow-No-Wake. The buoys are to conform to standard specifications for navigational markers.

Section 5: Controlled Area

- a) No person shall operate a boat faster than Slow-No-Wake in the

waters of Lake Sinissippi west of Stephans Point adjacent to the three (3) islands in the bay. The controlled area begins at the north end of the first island and ends at the south end of the third island reference attached Lake Sinissippi map.

Section 6: Posting Requirements

The Lake Sinissippi Improvement District covering Lake Sinissippi shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Lake Sinissippi Improvement District pursuant to the requirements of NR515 Wis. Administrative Code.

Section 7: Penalty

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section 8: Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Lake Sinissippi Improvement District Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section 9: Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
