

TOWN OF SUMMIT ORDINANCE REGULATING
BOATING ON LOWER NASHOTAH LAKE

THE TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of the Town of Summit, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, having by law village powers under Section 60.18(12) of the Wisconsin Statutes, deeming it necessary in order to promote safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with the public rights and interests and the capability of the water resource, and pursuant to Section 30.77 of the Wisconsin Statutes do ordain as follows:

Section 1. WATER SKIING.

Water skiing shall be prohibited on the waters of Lower Nashotah Lake, located in Section 12 and 13 of the Town of Summit between the hours of 2:00 P. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Saturdays and Sundays and all legal holidays.

Section 2. SLOW-NO WAKE.

No person shall operate a motorboat at a speed greater than a slow-no wake speed on Lower Nashotah Lake on Saturdays, Sundays and all legal holidays between the hours of 2:00 P. M. and 5:00 P. M.

Section 3. DEFINITIONS.

(a) "Slow-no wake" means operation of a motorboat at the slowest possible speed necessary to maintain steerage.

(b) "Motorboat" means any boat as defined in Sec. 30.50(2), Stats.

Section 4. PENALTY.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars upon conviction of the same offense a second or subsequent time within one year.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication. Publication shall consist of the posting of three (3) copies

thereof in three (3) public places in said Town.
