ORDINANCE # 741

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE MARKINGS ON THE BOATING HAZARDS ON PELICAN LAKE

The Town Board of the Town of Schoepke, County of Oneida, State of Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section I APPLICABILITY: That portion of Pelican Lake lying within the boundaries of the Township of Schoepke which is under the jurisdiction of the Town of Schoepke, County of Oneida, State of Wisconsin.

Section II PLACEMENT: Be it resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Schoepke, County of Oneida, State of Wisconsin enacts this ordinance for the placement of buoys in the waters of Pelican Lake for the protection of people and property. The buoys will be placed as required by the location of natural obstructions to boating safety and more specifically as indicated on the attached map.

Section III RESPONSIBILITY: It shall be the duty of the Town Board of the Town of Schoepke, County of Oneida, State of Wisconsin to be responsible for the placement of the buoys as early as possible each spring and for the removal of said buoys prior to the freeze-up each fall.

This ordinance shall be in effect on and after the 25th day of March, 1974.

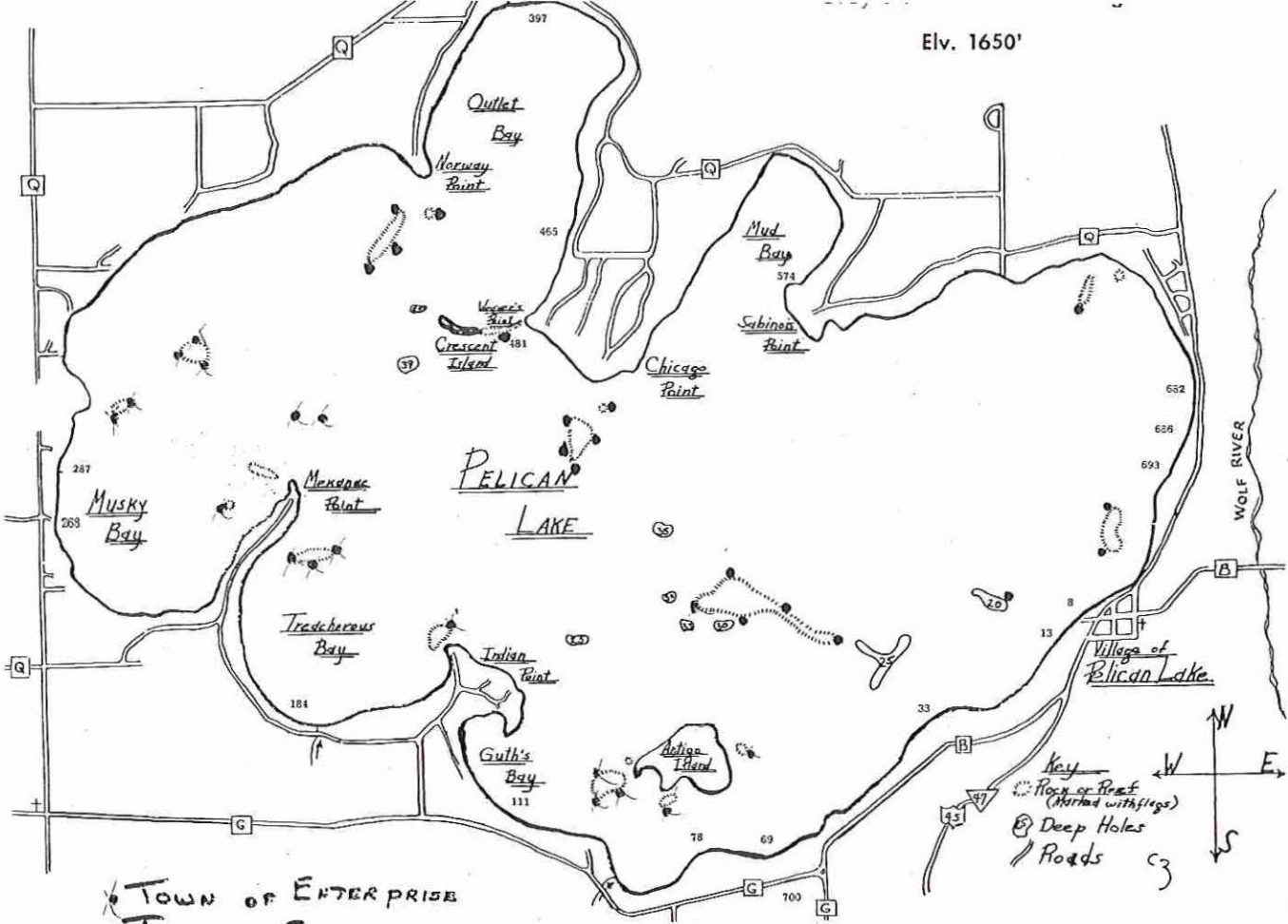
