ORDINANCE # 05-1996 Town of Newbold INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES PROHIBITED Pertaining to Redpine Lake Only

THE TOWN BOARD OF NEWBOLD, ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Applicability and Enforcement

A. The provisions of this ordinance will apply to the waters of Redpine Lake, a lake of less than 25 acres, lying wholly within Section 26 -Township 37 North - Range 8 East in the Town of Newbold

B. The ordinance shall be enforced by the Town Constable or any duly authorized officer of the Town of Newbold.

Section II: Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the Redpine Lake water resource.

Section III: Definitions

A. "Motorboat" means any watercraft used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water and propelled by machinery, whether or not such machinery is the principal source of propulsion.

Section IV: INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES PROHIBITED. The use of internal combustion engines on motorboats are prohibited on said Redpine Lake. Nothing in this provision affects the use of electric motors.

This Ordinance will become effective upon review per Section 30.77 (3) (d) of the Wisconsin Statues, passage, posting and publicizing as provided by Section 30.77 (4) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
