

ORDINANCE NO. 12 08 13A

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 330-19 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SALEM REGARDING THE PERMITTED METHODS OF BOAT PROPULSION ON ROCK LAKE.

The Town Board of the Town of Salem, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to protect environmental quality and preserve the quiet enjoyment of Rock Lake by limiting the propulsion of boats on Rock Lake to the use of oars, paddles, sails or electric motors.

SECTION 2. Section 330-19 Created. Section 330-19 of the Code of the Town of Salem is hereby created to provide as follows:

330-19 The propulsion of boats on Rock Lake shall be limited to the use of oars, paddles, sails or electric motors. This section shall not apply to:

- a. Any operation by duly authorized government or law enforcement officials in the course of the performance of their duties.
- b. Any operation necessitated by an emergency situation outside of the control of the operator of the motor boat.
- c. Any operation necessary for the mechanical or chemical management of weeds or other aquatic growth or shoreline restoration on Rock Lake by the holder of a permit issued by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
- d. Any operation necessary to complete a salvage operation on Rock Lake.

SECTION 3. Severability. Each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase and provision of the foregoing ordinance is and the same is hereby declared to be severable and if any portion or provision thereof is duly determined to be invalid for any reason, such determination shall not invalidate any other portion or provision thereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
