## VILLAGE OF CHENEQUA ORDINANCE NO. 131

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 80 Regulating Water Traffic, Boating and Water Sports Upon the Waters of Pine Lake.

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF CHENEQUA DOES ORDAIN

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 80, a boating regulation ordinance for Pine Lake, passed and adopted June 13, 1960, as amended by Ordinance No. 92 passed and adopted April 10, 1967, as further amended by Ordinance No. 99, passed and adopted February 9, 1970, is hereby amended in the following particulars:

SECTION 2. STATE BOATING AND WATER SAFETY LAWS ADOPTED. Section 3 of Ordinance 80 is hereby further amended by incorporating the following sections of the Wisconsin Statutes therein:

30.684	Chemical Tests
30.686	Report Arrest to Department

SECTION 3. PENALTIES. Section 13 of the Village of Chenequa Boating Ordinance is hereby further amended by repealing Section 13 and creating new Section 13 of the Village of Chenequa Boating Ordinance which shall read as follows:

> Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit to the Village of Chenequa not less than \$25 nor more than \$300 together with the costs of prosecution and in default of such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until full payment thereof is made, but not to exceed 60 days. In addition to any penalty for violations of Sections 30.681 or 30.684(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes, as adopted by this ordinance, the Court shall enter the orders required by subsections 30.80(6)(d) and (e) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and posting as provided by law.
