**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT ON WOLF LAKE**

**SECTION I. PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY**

This ordinance is in the interest of protecting natural resources and public safety, and is adopted pursuant to authority granted to Towns in section 30.77 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

**SECTION II. MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT PROHIBITED**

Except as otherwise provided for herein, the use of motorized watercraft is prohibited on Wolf Lake.

**SECTION III. SLOW-NO-WAKE REQUIREMENT**

Except as otherwise provided for herein, the use of watercraft on Wolf Lake shall be limited to a speed of slow-no-wake, as defined in sec. 30.50 (12) Wis. Stats.

**SECTION IV. EXEMPTIONS.**

The following watercraft shall be exempt from the provisions of this ordinance:

A. Watercraft operated by employees and/or contractors of the State of Wisconsin, Adams County or Town of Jackson, who are performing official maintenance or enforcement duties.

B. Watercraft operated by contractors retained by the Wolf Lake Association to perform maintenance activities.

**SECTION V. ORDINANCE NO. 3 REPEALED**

Town of Jackson Ordinance No. 3 is hereby repealed

**SECTION VI. PENALTY**

Any person who violates this ordinance is subject to a forfeiture as provided for in the town fee schedule adopted by the town board by resolution.

SECTION VII. POSTING PURSUANT TO 30.77(4) WIS. STATS.

A copy of this ordinance shall be posted at all public access points to Wolf Lake. A copy of the adopted ordinance shall also be filed with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

SECTION VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication in the Town Code of Ordinances.

SECTION IX. ADVISORY REVIEW

This ordinance shall be submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for advisory review pursuant to sec. 30.77(3)(d) Wis. Stats.


