

ORDINANCE NO. 92-4A

A JOINT ORDINANCE REGULATING BOATING ACTIVITY IN THE TOWN OF WASHINGTON AND THE TOWN OF LINCOLN.

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Washington and the Town of Lincoln do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. INTENT The intent of this ordinance is to provide healthful and safe conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY AND ENFORCEMENT The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters off Cranberry Lake, Catfish Lake, Duck Lake, Lynx Lake, Otter Lake and Eagle Lake within the jurisdiction of the Town of Washington and the Town of Lincoln. The provisions of the ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the water safety patrol.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS IN THIS ORDINANCE:

"Slow -no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steering control.

SECTION 4. SPEED RESTRICTIONS Slow-No-Wake areas shall be marked with buoys at mid channel of the line between the two reference points. All reference points are based on the lot lines at the waters edge edge of the river, lake or channel being described. Such Slow-No-Wake areas are as follows and as shown on the map

B. Southeast most Point of GL3, S15, T40N, R10E. (Pine Aire Campground)

The point between the line bearing S69°-54'-12"W 226.84' and

-SOP- 58'-32"W 63.63' as shown on Survey E 9287 Eagle Landmark Surveying, Inc.

5A. Otter-Eagle

A. 1" Iron pipe on NW Corner Outlot 1, S14, T40N, R10E, Plat of Eagle Acres. (David Ulrich) CN 741-26/V544-249. The Point between lines Bearing N70°- 56'-18"E476.93' and N44°- 28'-06"W315.68' as shown on Plat of Eagle Acres.

B. E Line of Lot 11, S5, T40N, R10E. (Fegers) CN 385/V531-668. 58, Otter-Eagle

A. NE Corner of Carl Waterman Property as described in Vol 408 Pg 41, N Line of Lot 14-2, More particularly described as N66°52'E 108.34; Morey Subdivision S23, T40N, R10E. CN 1151/V409-41.

B. E Line of Lot 49, Eagle Crest Plat, GL3, S23, T40N, R10E.(Eagle Lake Resort) V349-647 and V572-631.

9A. Catfish-Cranberry Thoroughfare

A. Southern most point of land of Lot 57 Plat of Everett Resort as described in Vol. 602 pg 674, S31, T40N, R11E. S Line of Lot 1, (Eckelmann)

Shady: Rest Plat S36, T40N, R10E, as described in Vol. 305 pg 210.

9B. E Line of Lot 37-3 and 38-3 S31, T40N, R11E, as described in vol. 377 pg 99. S Lot Line of Lot 19-1 Plat of Shady Rest as described in vol. 225 pg 567, S31, T40N, R11E.

Section 5. PENALTIES: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction of such violation be subject to the penalties as found in Wisconsin Statute 30.80 and hereby are adopted by reference.

Section 6. SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be construed to be unconstitutional or prohibited by law, such provision shall not be deemed to be an integral part of this Ordinance but shall be deemed severable and upon such decision shall be deemed severed from this Ordinance the same as if such provision had never been enacted; any such severance shall not be deemed or construed to affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Notice of this Ordinance shall be given as provided by law. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
