## ORDINANCE 206 BOATING - WILLOW RESERVOIR

206.000 A joint ordinance to regulate water traffic,

boating and water sports upon the waters of the Willow Reservoir, which are in the jurisdiction of the Town of Minocqua, Town of Lynn and the Town of Little Rice.

# 206.001 Enforcement:

(a) The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the Officers of the Minocqua Boat Patrol and Minocqua Police Department.

206.002 The Town Boards of the Town of Minocqua, Town of Lynn and Town of Little Rice, Oneida County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows.

### 206.003 Intent:

(a) The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

## 206.004 State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted:

(a) State Boating Laws as found in Wisconsin Statutes 30.50 to 30.71 and 30.80, are adopted by reference.

## 206.005 Special Events:

(a) There shall be no organized water events, special events, or contests without the express permission of the Town Boards of Minocqua and Lynn.

### 206.006 Penalties:

(a) Wisconsin State Boating Penalties as found in Wisconsin Statutes 30.80 are adopted by reference.

### 206.007 Severability:

(a) The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Minocqua and Lynn Town Hoards would have passed the other provisions] of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
