ORDINANCE 202 BOATING - TOMAHAWK LAKE

202.000 A joint ordinance to regulate water traffic,

boating and water sports upon the waters of Tomahawk Lake, which are in the jurisdiction of the Towns of Minocqua, Woodruff, Hazelhurst and Lake Tomahawk.

202.001 Enforcement:

(a) The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the Minocqua and Woodruff Boat Patrols and Officers of the Minocqua, Woodruff and Lake Tomahawk Police Departments.

202.002 The Town Boards of Minocqua, Woodruff, Hazelhurst and Lake Tomahawk, Oneida County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows.

202.003 Intent:

(a) The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

202.004 State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted:

(a) State Boating Laws as found in Wisconsin Statutes 30.50 to 30.71 and 30.80, are adopted by reference.

202.005 Definitions:

(a) SLOW-NO-WAKE: Means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

202.006 Slow-No-Wake Areas Designated:

(a) Between the island known as McCoy Island and

the mainland located in part of Gov t. Lot 3, Section 36, T39N, R6E, the area being further described as: An area located between the northeast corner of the lot line of Oneida County Tax Parcel number 2525-A then south for 225 feet.

202.007 Special Events:

(a) There shall be no organized water events, special events, or contests without the express permission of the Town Boards of Minocqua, Hazelhurst, Woodruff and Lake Tomahawk.

202.008 Penalties:

- (a) Wisconsin State Boating penalties as found in Wisconsin Statutes 30.80 are adopted by reference. 202.009 Severability:
- (a) The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Minocqua, Woodruff, Hazelhurst and Lake Tomahawk Town Boards would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
