### ORDINANCE 32 FOR SLOW WAKE AREA

# A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF CASTLE ROCK LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Town Board of the Town of Germantown do ordain as follows:

## Section 1. Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to waters of Castle Rock Lake
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the Officers of Juneau County or Constables of Germantown.

## Section II. Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

## Section III. State Boat and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30:50 to 30.71 Wi. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV. Definitions "Slow-No-Wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

# Section V. Controlled Area

No Person shall operate a boat faster than a slow-no-wake in the waters of Port O'Call Bay beginning entrance of bay and ending Garden Channel at any time.

## Section VI. Posting Requirements

The Town of Germantown shall place and maintain a copy of this Section at all public access points within the; jurisdiction of the Township

## Section VII Penalties

Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in ss. 30.80, Wi. Stats.\_ are adopted by reference

## Section VIII Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the applicant on of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

### Section IX Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
