

ORDINANCE NUMBER 022599

A Sole Ordinance to regulate Jet Skis, Water Skiing, Kneeboarding, tubing etc. upon the water of Musser Lake between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. and prescribing penalties for violation thereof.

The Town of Worcester Board of the Town of Worcester do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

(a) The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Musser Lake.

Section II. Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of Aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water Resources.

Section III. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in SS 30.50 to 30.71 Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV. Definitions

(a) Jet Skis, water skiing, kneeboarding, tubing, etc.

Section V. Jet Skis, water skiing, kneeboarding, tubing, etc. No person shall operate a jet skis, water ski or operate any motorboat towing a person engaged in water skiing, kneeboarding , tubing or similar activity during the hours of 9:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. local time.

Section VI. Posting Requirements

The Town of Worcester shall place and maintain a copy of this Section at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town.

Section VII. Penalties

Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in S 30.80, Wis Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section VIII. Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared That the Town of Worcester Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provisions of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX. Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
