15.02 SMALL BOAT HARBOR.

(1) MARAIS DE ST. FERIOLE. The provisions of this section shall apply to the waters of the Marais de St. Feriole, which are bounded and described as follows:

On the south by the north line of the old Washington Street dike, on the north by a line parallel to and 800 feet north of the aforesaid south boundary, and on the east and west by the east and west banks of the Marais de St. Feriole, herein after referred to as the Small Boat Harbor.

- 2) BOAT SPEED REGULATED. No person shall operate a boat within the small boat harbor at a speed greater than "Slow No Wake". For the purposes of this section, "Slow No Wake" means the slowest possible speed so as to maintain steerage.
- (3) SWIMMING AND WATER SKIING PROHIBITED. No person shall swim, bathe or water ski within the area of the Small Boat Harbor at any time.
- (4) RECKLESS OPERATION PROHIBITED. No person shall operate, direct or handle a boat within said Small Boat Harbor in such manner as to unreasonably annoy, unnecessarily frighten or endanger the occupants of his or other boats.
- 15.10 PENALTY. Any person who shall violate any provision of this subchapter shall be subject to a penalty as provided in sec. 25.04 of this Code. Amended, passed and approved June 1, 1982.
