

ORDINANCE NO. C6-79-172

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CHIEF OF POLICE TO INSTALL REGULATORY MARKERS IN AREAS OF THE YAHARA RIVER AND LAKE MONONA WHICH ARE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONONA WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In Section 17.191 of the Municipal Code of the City of Monona is hereby created to read.

17.191 SLOW-NO-WAKE REGULATORY MARKERS IN WIDESPREAD AREA OF YAHARA RIVER.

(1) Chief of Police May Authorize. The Chief of Police, when requested by law enforcement officials of Dane County and approved by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, may authorize the installation of regulatory markers in the waters of the Yahara River and Lake Monona within the jurisdiction of the City designating such areas as slow-no-wake zones in which no person shall operate a boat at a speed faster than the slowest possible speed so as to maintain steerage if in his/her judgment such zones are necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the persons within the City of Monona and when all costs of acquisition and erection of such regulatory markers will be borne by Dane County and/or the State of Wisconsin.

(2) Enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced under Section 30.66(3) Wis. Stats. Any complaints of violation of this ordinance filed with the Monona Police Department shall be forwarded to the Dane County Sheriff's Department or the District Attorney's office for prosecution.

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of Section 25.02 of the Municipal Code of the City of Monona, relating to conflict and severability, shall apply to the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
