ORDINANCE NO. 87-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SWIMMING AREA AT PARTRIDGE LAKE BEACH

The Village Board of the Village of Fremont, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. INTENT. The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. APPLICABILITY AND ENFORCEMENT. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Partridge Lake (SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T21N, R13E) within the jurisdiction of the Village of Fremont, Waupaca County. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the Village of Fremont and Waupaca County.

Section 3. STATE BOATING & SAFETY LAWS ADOPTED. State boating laws as found in SS 30.50 to 30.71 are adopted by reference.

Section 4. DEFINITION. (a) "Swimming zone" means an authorized area of water established by regulatory markers to designate a swimming area.

Section 5. RESTRICTED AREA. It shall be unlawful to operate any watercraft on Partridge Lake, in the Village of Fremont, in the safety area designated and marked by buoys.

The following area marked by swim area buoy markers on Partridge Lake is designated as follows:

- (a) Buoy "A" is located approximately 250 feet directly north out from Lake Street.
- (b) Buoy "B" is located approximately 75 feet directly west of buoy "A".
- (c) Buoy "C" is located approximately 75 feet directly east of buoy "A".

Section 6. PENALTIES. Any person violating this ordinance shall forfeit not more than \$50.00 for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$100.00 upon conviction of the same offense a second or subsequent time with—in one year.

Section 7. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
