

An Ordinance establishing the Mercer Tourist Park swimming beach, a public beach for general use by the public and limiting the use of boats within the boundary lines of the proposed restricted swimming area.

The Town board of the Town of Mercer do ordain as follows;

Section 1: That the beach at the Mercer Tourist Park in the Run of Mercer, Iron County, Wisconsin, is now established as a swimming beach open to the public for its general use and pleasure.

Section 2. That a restricted swimming area shall be defined by use of floating buoys covering an area at the Mercer Tourist Park on Grand Portage Lake in the Town of Mercer, of 150 feet from the shoreline to the lake and 200 feet in width creating a swimming area 150 feet by 200 feet at the center of which shall be a dock and diving board.

Section 3. No person or persons shall operate any boat with or without a motor or any other type of floating conveyance used as a boat within the boundary lines of the restricted area defined in Section 2,

Section 4. Any person or persons convicted of violating this ordinance shall upon conviction be ordered to pay a forfeiture not exceeding Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, any person so convicted shall be imprisoned in the county jail of iron County for not more than Ten. (10) days or until such forfeiture and costs are paid.

This ordinance shall take affect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Passed and adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Mercer, Iron County, Wisconsin, at a regular session thereof which was on the 16th day of March 1970.
