

Ordinance No. 70-2

An ordinance pertaining to the Town of Washington Shoreline and swimming areas

The Town Board, Town of Washington, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows,

Section A

(1) No person shall operate a boat in excess of five (5) miles per hour within an area clearly marked in accordance with law of buoys or some other distinguishing device as a bathing or swimming area or other restricted use areas, except in the case of emergency or to patrol or rescue craft,

(2) No person shall move, remove, molest, tamper with, destroy or attempt to destroy or moor or fasten a boat (except to mooring buoys) to any navigational aids or regulatory markers.

Section B.

Any person, firm or corporation who fails to comply with any provisions of the ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 together with the costs of prosecution for each violation and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Eau Claire County, Wisconsin until payment of such forfeiture and costs, but not exceeding 30 days.

Section C.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting as provided by law. All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or contrary hereto are hereby repealed, except nothing in this ordinance shall be interpreted so as to conflict with state laws or orders for the navigable waters or any of the requirements of any ordinance of the Town of Washington not mentioned or made inapplicable by the express terms of the ordinance.

Section D.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at the regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Washington on the 6th day of August 1970.
