

AN ORDINANCE PROMOTING WATER SAFETY AND MAXIMUM UTILIZATION OF LAKE EMILY, LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF COMMONWATH, FLORENCE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, BY REGULATING THE HOURS OF WATER SKIING AND HIGH SPEED MOTORBOAT OPERATIONS.

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate motorboats in excess of slow-no-wake speeds during the hours of 6pm and 10am. Slow-no-wake is defined as the slowest possible speed so as to maintain steerage.

Section 2.

It will be the responsibility of the Commonwealth Town Board to post this regulation in prominent location at the public access point covered under this ordinance.

Section 3.

Violators of this ordinance shall forfeit no more than \$50.00 for the first offence and shall forfeit not more than 100 upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.

Section 4.

SAVING CLAUSE. The several terms and provisions of the ordinance shall be deemed severable, and if any provisions of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5.

This ordinance, offered and adopted by the Commonwealth Town Board Jun 4, 1979, subject to advisory review by State of Wisconsin DNR, is effective December 20, 1979.
