ORDINANCE NO. 2-1996

An Ordinance providing for the amendment of "Chapter XIII - Moat Operation and Use of Lilly Lake" of thee of Ordinance codes of the Town of Wheatland, Kenosha County, Wisconsin.

The Town Board of the Town of Wheatland, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter XIII of the Town of Wheatland Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding the following sections:

13.37. Lilly Lake Beach Park Area Boat Parking Restrictions. No person shall allow his or her boat to be docked, grounded, or remain unattended on the shore of the Lilly Lake Beach Park area. Whether or not such boat is attended, no person shall allow his or her boat to be docked, grounded, or otherwise remain on the shore of Lilly Lake in the Lilly Lake Beach Park area situated southwest of the boat ramp. 13.38. Other anchorage restrictions and navigation buoy. The Town has established a dry hydrant near the west shore of Lilly Lake for use by the Wheatland Fire Department to fill fire trucks with water. In order to protect the submerged end of that dry hydrant from damage caused by boats anchoring in the area, no person may anchor any boat or watercraft within 50 feet of the dry hydrant so established. A buoy, waterway marker, or other aid to navigation indicating "NO ANCHORING" is authorized to be placed in this area of Lilly Lake pursuant to state regulations and permitting requirements.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance and the Sections of Chapter XIII created hereunder shall become effective after its passage and publication as required by law.
