

ORDINANCE NO. 13. 00
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING BOATING

The Village Board of the Village of Lac La Belle, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. BOATING REGULATIONS.

(a) Intent. The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of the aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resources of Lac La Belle located in the Village of Lac La Belle.

(b) Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this Section shall apply to the waters of Lac La Belle within the jurisdiction of the Village of Lac La Belle. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced by Village of Lac La Belle law enforcement officers.

(c) State Boating and Water Laws Adopted. The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and relating water activities and safety as found in Sections 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties to be imposed or the punishment for violation of said statutes, are hereby adopted and, by reference, made a part of this Ordinance. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutory regulations incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this Ordinance.

(d) Penalties. The Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Sec. 30.80, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference and are applicable to violations of this Ordinance.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.
