

## ORDINANCE NO.

### AN ORDINANCE REGULATING BOATING ACTIVITY TOWN OF WASHINGTON

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Washington, Vilas County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

#### Section 1

The statutory provisions of Sections 30.50 to 30.71, inclusive, and all rules of the Department of Natural Resources enacted pursuant thereto, describing and defining regulations with respect to boating, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties to be imposed for the punishment for the violation of such statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Ordinance as is fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this Ordinance.

#### Section 2

Slow-No-Wake Speed: All boats shall be operated at a Slow-No-Wake Speed in the areas herein set forth. Slow-No-Wake Speed shall be defined to mean the minimum speed at which it is possible to operate a boat and still maintain steerage. The areas in which boats are to be operated at Slow-No-Wake Speed are as follows:

1. An area beginning at the dock in front of the PineAire Resort in Duck Lake and going to 200 feet East of the end of the thoroughfare in Lynx Lake and a buoy should be appropriately located in each location.
2. Beginning at the Otter Lake Trailer Court dock in Otter Lake to the Eagle Lake Resort dock in Eagle Lake and 2 buoys shall be placed at each location.
3. A thoroughfare between Eagle and Voyageur Lakes, beginning at the Golf View Resort dock to the A-Frame Motel dock and 2 buoys to be placed at each location.
4. A thoroughfare between Voyageur and Catfish Lakes beginning at the point of the Smile-A-While Resort and to a point 100 feet South of the Highway 70 bridge, 2 buoys to be placed at each location.
5. A thoroughfare between Catfish and Cranberry Lakes beginning at the point on the North side of the thoroughfare by the "Masters Haven" property to the point by the Shady Rest Resort in Cranberry Lake and 2 buoys to be placed at each location.
6. A thoroughfare between Eagle and Scattering Rice Lakes, the area to be 100 feet on either side of the point of land on the North side of the thoroughfare and 1 buoy to be placed at each location.
7. At the mouth of the Deerskin River in Scattering Rice Lake and continuing up the river and a buoy to be appropriately located at the mouth.
8. At the mouth of the Nine Mile Creek in Cranberry Lake and continuing up the river and a buoy to be appropriately located at the mouth.

#### Section 3

Penalties: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction of such violation be subject to a penalty which shall be as follows:

- A. First Offense-Penalty: Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00 together with the costs of prosecution.
- B. The Second Offense-Penalty: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Ordinance or part of this Ordinance who shall previously have been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance within one year shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$200.00 for each such offense, together with the costs of prosecution.

#### Section 4

Nothing in this Ordinance shall preclude the Town from maintaining any appropriate action to prevent or remove a violation of any provision of this Ordinance. Whenever any person fails to pay any forfeiture and costs of prosecution upon the order of the Court for violation of any provisions of this Ordinance, the Court may issue an execution against the property of the Defendant for said forfeiture and costs.

#### Section 5

Severability: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be construed to be unconstitutional or prohibited by law, such provision shall not be deemed to be an integral part of this Ordinance but shall be deemed severable and upon such decision shall be deemed severed from this Ordinance the same as if such provision had never been enacted; any such severance shall not be deemed or construed to affect any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 6

Notice of this Ordinance shall be given as provided by law. This Ordinance shall take affect upon passage and publication.
