## **ORDINANCE NO. 41 Boating**

Pierce County, Wisconsin

An Ordinance regulating boating and related activities upon the Water of Pierce County, Wis.

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Pierce, State of Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1- The statutory provisions describing and defining regulation with respect to boats and water safety in the following enumerated Statutes, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties imposed of the punishment for violation of said Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any Statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this Ordinance.

Section 2-30.50 through 30.71.

Section 3- Penalties: any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than one Dollar and not more than fifty Dollars together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County jail until such forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be paid but not exceeding 90 days.

Section 4-The District Attorney is hereby authorized to commence and prosecute action for violations of this Ordinance.

Section 5-Any person who has seen a violation of this ordinance or any constable, highway policeman, sheriff, deputy sheriff, or other office, who has reason to believe that a violation has been made may sign a complaint.

Section 6-The forfeitures provided in this Ordinance are to be collected by the court in which the action is tried or plea made and by said Court turned over to the County Treasurer who shall place such forfeiture in the Law Enforcement Account.

Section 7-The provision of the Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the County Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid and if any provision of this ordinance is held to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall

not be effected thereby except insofar as specifically adjudicated upon.

Section 8-The effective date of this Ordinance shall be from and after its passage and adoption, and publication.
