

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20.01(3) OF THE TOWN OF OCONOMOWOC GENERAL CODE OF ORDINANCES AND SECTION 20.02 OF THE TOWN OF MERTON GENERAL CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO STATE BOATING AND WATER SAFETY LAWS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE

The Town Board of the Town of Oconomowoc and the Town Board of the Town of Merton, each being a municipality as defined in Chapter 30 of the Wisconsin Statutes and each having jurisdiction of a portion of Okauchee Lake, an inland lake located in Waukesha County, do ordain jointly and identically in conformity with §30.77 and §30.81, Wis. Stats., as follows:

As pertains to the Town of Oconomowoc:

SECTION 1. Section 20.01(3) of the General Code of Ordinances of the Town of Oconomowoc is hereby amended to add to state boating and water safety laws adopted, the following sections:

30.681 Intoxicated Boating

30.682 Preliminary Breath Screening Test

30.683 Implied Consent:

30.684 Chemical Tests

30.686 Report Arrests to Department

30.687 Officer's Action After Arrest for Violating Intoxicated Boating Law

As pertains to the town of Merton:

SECTION 2. Section 20.02 of the General Code of Ordinances of the Town of Merton is hereby amended to add to state boating and water safety laws adopted, the following sections:

30.681 Intoxicated Boating

30.682 Preliminary Breath Screening Test

30.683 Implied Consent

30.684 Chemical Tests

30.686 Report Arrests to Department

30.687 Officer's Action After Arrest for Violating Intoxicated Boating Law

SECTION 3. PENALTIES. Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in §30.80, Wis. Stats., and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference with all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and they are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE; CLERK'S DUTIES. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication or posting by the Town Board of the Town of Merton and the Town Board of the Town of Oconomowoc as provided by law.
