ORDINANCE #20010613

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A SLOW - NO WAKE LIMIT FOR DRUMMOND LAKE AND AT DESIGNATED PLACES ON LAKE OWEN

The Drummond Town Board does hereby ordain:

Section 1: Applicability and Enforcement (a) The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the following: 1) All of Lake Drummond 2) Designated places on Lake Owen: The narrows at Keland's boat house N 46017 239 ft, W 091013 219 ft.-to N 46 degrees 17 273 ft., W 091013 140 ft. The narrows at the entrance to Otter Bay N 46015 558 ft, W 091015 050 ft. to N 46015 605 ft., W 091015 047 ft. The narrows at the north end of Carter Island, south to the mid point of Carter's peninsula N 46016 403 ft, W 091014 385 ft. to N 46016 516 ft, W 091014 260 ft. to N 46016 720 ft., W 091014 075 ft.

(b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Drummond and Bayfield County.

Section 2: Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest, and the capability of the water resources

Section 3: State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted State boating laws as found is ss. 30.50 to 30.71 are adopted by reference.

Section 4: Definitions

No person shall operate a boat at a speed faster than "Slow - No Wake," as, defined in 30.50(12), Wisconsin Statutes 1997-98, as "that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control."

Section 5: Posting Requirements

Duly, the Town of Drummond shall post and maintain a copy of this Section at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town.

Section 6: Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stats. 30.80 and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section 7: Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section 8: Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
