

TOWN OF BELLE PLAINS SHAWANO COUNTY - WISCONSIN

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SWIMMING AREA, WALLEYE BED AREA AND SLOW NO WAKE AREA PURSUANT TO SECTION 30.77 (2) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES.

The Town Board of the Town of Belle Plaine, Shawano County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a swimming area and provide safe and enjoyable aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource; placement of buoys marking the walleye beds and marking slow no wake near the culvert between Grass Lake and Round Lake.

Section 2. Regulatory Markers. Buoys indicating the swimming area on Pine Lake shall read SWIM AREA; buoys warning of the walleye bed area shall read ROCK; and buoys indicating the slow-no-wake area in Grass Lake shall read SLOW NO WAKE.

Section 3. Applicability and Enforcement. The provision of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Pine Lake located in Section 34 Township 26 Range 15E and Grass Lake located in Section 33 Township 26 Range 15E. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of Shawano County.

Section 4. State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted. The State of Wisconsin boating laws as found in Wisconsin Statutes Section 30.50 through 30.71 are adopted by reference.

Section 5. Area Designated. The areas designated shall be as follows:

Swimming Area - Section 34 Township 26 Range 15E. 50 feet x 100 feet. Sandy Beach.

Walleye Bed Area - Section 33 Township 26 Range 15E. 50 feet x 50 feet.

Slow No Wake Area - Section 33 Township 26 Range 15E. 100 feet x 100 feet.

Section 6. Penalty Section. Pursuant to Section 30.80 (1) of the Wisconsin Statutes. Any person violating any provision of ss. 30.50 to 30.71 for which a penalty is not provided by sub. (2), (3) or. (4) shall forfeit not more than \$50 for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$100 upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.

Section 7. Effective Date of Ordinance. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
