AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A WATERSKI PICKUP AND DROP AREA PURSUANT TO SECTION 30.69(3) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

The Common Council of the City of Eagle River, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section One. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a waterski pickup and dropoff area and provide for safe and enjoyable aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and the capability of the water resource.

Section Two. Applicability and Enforcement.

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Yellow Birch Lake within the jurisdiction of the City of Eagle River and the Town of Lincoln, Vilas County, Wisconsin. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the police of the City of Eagle River.

Section Three. State and and Water Safety Laws Adopted.

The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety found in Section 30.69(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes is hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section Four. Area Designated.

The area designated as a waterski pickup and dropoff area shall be an area 100 feet on either side of the presently existing dock owned by the City of Eagle River and commonly known as the "T Dock" located in Section 28, Township 40 North, Range 10 East, Vilas County, Wisconsin. The area shall be designated by buoys which meet the standards set forth in the Wisconsin Administrative Code NR5.09.

Section Five. Time Restrictions.

The waterski pickup and dropoff area designated by this ordinance shall be used as such waterski pickup and dropoff area during the following times only: Monday and Wednesday of each week, 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. and 7:00P.M. to 8:00 P.M.; Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday of each week 7:00 P.M. to 9:30 P.M.; Friday of each week, 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Section Six. Penalty Section.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$50.00 for the first offense and subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$100.00 upon conviction of the same offense a second or subsequent time within a one year period.
