

ORDINANCE # 4-15-82

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PLACEMENT OF BUOYS ON FISH LAKE, LOCATED IN TOWNS OF DEERFIELD AND HANCOCK AND VILLAGE OF HANCOCK, WAUSHARA COUNTY, STATE OF WISCONSIN AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF.

The Town Boards of the Town of Deerfield, Town of Hancock, and Village Board of the Village of Hancock, located in the County of Waushara, State of Wisconsin, hereby authorize the placement of slow-no-wake buoys on the narrows and buoys marking the swimming area at Hancock Park on Fish Lake to be located at the following; positions.

West buoy on narrows will be approximately 150 feet from pipe on beach in a line from the house owned by Tom Rooney. East buoy 360 feet southeast of first buoy in line with Tom Rooney's house and second pipe on shore. This will be approximately 100 feet between east buoy and second pipe located on shore.

The buoys located in the narrows are "slow-no-wake" buoys and that no boat shall operate at a speed in excess of slow-no-wake between said buoys. Definition of slow-no-wake is from Sec. 30.50 (10) WI Statutes which reads slow-no-wake means that speed at which a boat moves slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Penalty for violation of the speed limit shall be \$25.00.

At the Hancock Park Swimming Area buoys will be placed starting at west end of steps of the Bath house, 110 feet south to placement of first buoy. Then approximately 75 feet east to second buoy, then approximately 110 feet north, then 75 feet west to point of beginning. This is the officially designated swimming area.
