

Ordinance # 15

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE WATER TRAFFIC, BOATING AND WATER SPORTS UPON THE WATERS OF BIG TWIN LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Town Board of the Town of Langlade, State of Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Intent. The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Big Twin Lake within the jurisdiction of the Town of Langlade. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the town and town constable.

Section 3. State boating and water safety laws as defined in state statutes in respect to water traffic, boats and related water activities are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 4. No one shall operate any boat beyond slow-no wake speed on the waters of Twin Lake. A "slow-no-wake" which means the slowest possible speed so as to maintain steerage shall be in effect and enforced.

Section 5. Penalties. (1) Any person violating any provision of SS 30.50 to 30.80 for which a penalty is not provided by sub.(2),(3) or (4) shall forfeit not more than \$50.00 for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$100.00 upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.

(2) Any person violating s. 30.67 (1) or 30.68 (1) or (2) shall be fined not more than \$200 or imprisoned not more than six months or both. Any person violating s 30.68 shall be required to obtain a certificate of satisfactory completion of a safety course under 30.74(1). Any person violating s 30.67 (2) shall forfeit not more than \$200.

(3) Any person violating s30.71 or any rule promulgated under that section shall forfeit not more than \$100 for the first offenses and shall forfeit not more than \$200 upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.

(4) Any person violating any provision of s.30.72 or the rules adopted Pursuant thereto shall be fined not more than 30 days, or both, for the first offense, and not more than \$200 or imprisoned for not more than 90 days or both, upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.

Whereas the Town Board of the Town of Langlade has made the following Ordinance # 15 a matter of Town record by due process their signatures upon this ordinance make it legal and statutory, Enforceable by the Town Constable.
