## ORDINANCE #92-1A

## AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE WATER TRAFFIC, BOATING AND WATER SPORTS UPON THE WATERS OF KINNEY LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

LITTLE LAKE, BUCKS LAKES, LONG LAKE AND LEMKE LAKE ARE UNDER STATE LAW BY STATUE.

The Town Board of the Town of Dupont, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Intent. The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to waters of Kinney Lake, Little Lake, Bucks Lakes, Long Lake and Lemke Lake within the jurisdiction of the Town of Dupont. The provisions of this ordinance will be enforced by the officers of the Waupaca County Sheriff Department and Water Patrol Officers.

Section 3. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted. State Boating laws as found in Js. 30.50 to 30.71 are adopted by reference.

Section 4. Definitions. (a) "slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Section 5. Speed Restrictions. A slow-no-wake speed limit is established for Kinney Lake between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:00 a.m. daily. No person shall operate a motorboat at a speed greater than slow no-wake during this period.

Section 6. Penalties. Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in ss. 30.80 are adopted by reference.

Section 7. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
