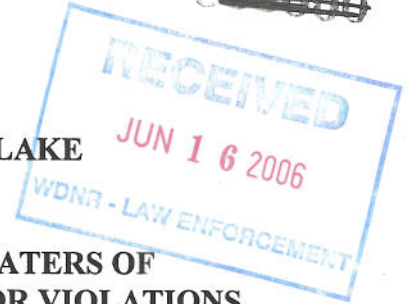

SLOW-NO-WAKE AREAS: SCATTERING RICE LAKE



A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF SCATTERING RICE LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Town Board of the Town of Washington do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Scattering Rice Lake.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the County of Vilas.

Section II. Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss.30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV. Definitions

- (a) "Slow-no-wake" means that the speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Section V. Controlled Area

No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of Scattering Rice Lake in the following locations, at any time:

Section VI. Posting Requirements

The Town of Washington shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

Section VII Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VIII Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.


Section IX Effective Date


DESCRIPTION OF SLOW-NO-WAKE AREAS: SCATTERING RICE LAKE

BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) 4 buoys will be placed on the southeast corner of the island in Scattering Rice Lake in 6 to 8 feet of water.
- 2) Three (3) buoys will be placed on the east and southeast shore of Scattering Rice Lake in approx. 6 feet of water. (South of the Deerskin River).
- 3) Three (3) buoys will be placed on the northeast corner of Scattering Rice Lake in approx. 6 feet of water. (North of the Deerskin River).
