- (6) Landing Aircraft in Altoona Lake. Seaplanes or other aircraft capable of landing on water be and are hereby prohibited from landing on Lake Altoona, where said Lake Altoona, adjoins or lies in the corporate limits of the City of Altoona, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin; that such prohibited areas shall be designated by standard marking devices for aircraft.
- (7) Boats with motors regulated on waters within and adjacent to the City of Altoona.
- 1. Operating Regulations.
- a.Speed All motor boats shall be operated at a safe and reasonable speed consistant with existing conditions.
- b.Occupants No motor boat shall at any time carry passengers beyond its safe capacity.
- c.Operator's Age No person under sixteen (16) years of age shall be permitted to operate any motor boat except in the presence of his parent or guardian.
- 2. Inspection. All boats shall at all times be subject to inspection by the Police Department of the City of Altoona or any other person designated by the Chief of Police for seaworthiness or fitness generally. No boat shall be operated in violation of any orders made as the result of such inspection until the defect has been remedied and approval obtained from the Chief of Police or authorized person as aforesaid.
- 3. Boat Races, No part of this ordinance shall apply to boat races, regattas, etc., or meets duly authorized by the City Council. Such may be held by organized bodies upon approval by the Council and in accordance with regulations procured by it.
- 4. Enforcement. The Police Department of the City of Altoona shall enforce provisions of this ordinance and the Chief of Police may deputize any duly appointed life guard or other qualified person to assist in said enforcement.

Section 12.01 (B) of the Code of General Ordinances is amended to add the followings (1) No person shall operate a boat not to exceed five (5) miles

per hour within an area clearly marked in accordance with law by buoys or some other distinguishing device as a bathing or swimming area or other restricted use areas, except in the case of emergency or to patrol or rescue craft.

(2) No person shall move, remove, molest, tamper with, destroy or attempt to destroy or moor or fasten a boat (except to mooring buoys) to any navigational aide or regulatory markers.
