

ORDINANCE # 7 -96

ANY MOTOR DRIVEN WATER CRAFT EQUIPMENT ORDINANCE

A sole ordinance to regulate any type of motorize equipment upon the waters of Kangaroo Lake being on the North side of the causeway and prescribing penalties for violation thereof.

The Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Applicability and Enforcement:

- a. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Kangaroo Lake North side of the Causeway.
- b. This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Baileys Harbor Town Constable position.

Section II Intent:

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted:

State boating laws as found in State Statutes 30.50 to 30.71, WI.. Statutes are adopted by reference.

Section IV Motor Water Craft prohibited Area:

No person shall operate a motorboat, as defined in WI. State Statutes 30.50 (6), that is propelled by internal combustion engine or engines on the waters of Kangaroo Lake north of the Causeway. Electric motors only are permitted on said waters.

Section V Posting Requirements:

The Town of Baileys Harbor shall place and maintain a copy of this Section at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the water way which this ordinance sets forth in Section I.

Section VI Penalties:

Penalties. Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in S. 30.80, WI.. Statutes, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference with all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VIII Severability:

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX Effective Date:

This section will be come effective upon passage by the Town Board, with approval from the DNR and posted at the lake's access points within our jurisdiction.
