## BOATING REGULATIONS

(a) Columbia Lake.

(1) The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

(2) The use of any motor powered boat on Columbia Lake is prohibited except as authorized in Subsection (a)(3) of this Ordinance.

(3) Wisconsin Power and Light Company has certain obligations to maintain Columbia Lake and is authorized to use said lake in conjunction with the operation of its power plant adjacent to the lake. This Ordinance shall not restrict said corporation or

operation of its power plant adjacent to the lake. This Ordinance shall not restrict said corporation or its authorized agents from using motor powered

boats on Columbia Lake in the performance of its maintenance obligations, or in conjunction with its operation of such power plant.

(4) Each and every provision of this Ordinance is deemed and hereby declared to be severable from each and every other provision and if, for any reason,

any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions shall remain in full

force and effect the same as if such invalid or unenforceable provision had never been enacted. (b) Penalty. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 1.03 of this Code.
