

ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 1982

Introduced by -Park and Snowmobile Committee

INTENT & SYNOPSIS: To establish a swimming area pursuant to Section 30.77(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF ADAMS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a swimming area and provide safe and enjoyable aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Patrick Lake within the jurisdiction of Adams County. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by all persons authorized to do so pursuant to Adams County Park Ordinance #2, Sec. 11.3 and 11.4.

Section 3. State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted. The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water activities and safety found in the following enumerated section of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance. 30.68(7) Restricted Areas

Section 4. Area Designated. The area designated as a swimming area shall be as follows: T.16N.,R. 7E., SW 1/4 NW1/4, Sec. 10, Town of New Chester. Commencing approximately 75 feet Southwest of the Northeast Patrick Lake County Park/property shoreline, thence commencing Southwest another 150 feet along the shoreline to designate a public swim area. The area shall be designated by buoys which meet the standards set in Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 5.09.

Section 5. Penalty Section. The above shall be in strict conformity with Section 30.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
