## TOWN of EAU PLEINE

## SKI CLUB ORDINANCE WATERSKI -97

A sole ordinance to regulate boating upon the waters of the Town of Eau Pleine in Portage County Wisconsin and prescribing penalties for violations thereof.

## The TOWN BOARD of EAU PLEINE does ordain as follows:

- 1. Applicability and enforcement. The provisions on this ordinance shall apply to those waters within the jurisdiction of the Town of Eau Pleine. This ordinance shall be enforced by the Portage County Sheriff's Department and any other authorized law enforcement officer.
- 3. Intent. The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources. State boating laws and safety laws adopted. State boating laws as found in ss.30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.
- 4. Definitions. Definitions found in ss.30.50 to 30.71, Wis Stats., are adopted by reference.
- 5. Water-ski pick-up/drop area. Lake DuBay reservoir "South Bay "Beach" public access that area within 100 feet of the water ski dock located 540 feet south of the public boat launch.
- 6. Posting requirements. This ordinance car information within this ordinance shall be prominently posted (by the ski club) at all public access points in the Town of Eau Pleine as required by ss.30.77(4), Wis Stats.
- 7. Penalties. Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in ss30.80, Wis Stats., and deposits as established in the uniform deposit and bail schedule established by the Wisconsin judicial conference, are hereby adopted by reference with the references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.
- 8. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid, if any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstance shall not be effected.
- 9. Effective date. This ordinance will become effective upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
