WHEREAS, as the Town of Hayward, Sawyer County Wisconsin maintains a public bathing beach on Hinton Bay of Round Lake in an area generally described as Public Land and Lot 44 of Round Lake Park Flat of Sawyer County and,

MHEREAS, the Town of Hayward deems it to be in the interest of public health or safety relative to the use or operation of boats, or any activity regulated by Section 30.60 to 20.71 Wisconsin Statutes, as authorized therein; and,

WHEREAS the Town of Hayward desires to obtain authority to place bouys upon the water of Hinton Bay on Round Lake as authorized by Wiscosin DNR regulation 5.09 to the end that the area defined by this resolution may be restricted and regulated as to the use of the area so defined for any purpose except bathing.

WON THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the swim area of Hinton Bay on Round Lake beach shall be designated by the placing of bouys in the waters of Round Lake, said bouys to be of a size prescribedby Wisconsin DNR Regulations and to contain the markings and symbols required for a swim area;

BE IT further resolved that the exact location of said bouys and beach shall be as follows: Starting at an iron stake located on the South West corner of Lot 43 of Round Lake park plat, dawyer County, thence running into the water in a Northerly direction of 120 feet where the first bouy is placed, thence West 85 feet where the second bouy will be placed, thence South 120 feet to a point which is 35 feet West of the South East corner of Lot 44, Round Lake Park thence a distance of 85 feet East to the point of beginning. Said South Line to be along the Town Road. See Map on the following page.
