## ORDINANCE 95-7

The Town Board of the Town of Wescott does ordain as follows:

1. AUTHORITY. The board acts pursuant to its powers as set forth in Chapter 30 of the Wisconsin statutes, including s. 30.81, following receipt of public comments, further acting under its village powers.

2. PURPOSE. To promote the health, safety and welfare of the town through lowering of accident risk, to limit erosion problems and stream bank deterioration, and for enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and capability of the water resources.

3. DEFINITION. "Slow - no wake" means that speed at which a boat or personal watercraft moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

4. PROHIBITION. No person shall operate a motor boat or personal watercraft in excess of slow - no wake on the body of water that connects Washington Lake and Loon Lake, located in Section 12, T. 27 N., R. 16 E.

5. PENALTY. Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in s. 30.80 Wis. Stats., or its successor, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference, except the town penalty shall be forfeitures with no imprisonment unless ordered by a court for contempt sanction.

6. NOTICE. The Clerk shall mail or have delivered a copy of this ordinance to the local DNR office and Sheriffs Department, with regulation signs placed in compliance with state standards at the site.
