

BOATING ORDINANCE
Town of Molitor
Taylor County, Wisconsin.

The Town Board of the Town of Molitor do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Sackett Lake.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Molitor and the Taylor County Sheriff's Department.

Section II. Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71 are adopted by reference.

Section IV. Motor Boat Prohibited Area

No person shall operate a motorboat, as defined in 30.50(6), Wisconsin Statutes 1988, that is propelled by internal combustion engine or engines. Said motorboat prohibited areas are:

- (1) Sackett Lake, lying in Section 36, Township 32 North, Range 1 West.

Section V. Markers and Navigational Aids

Posting Ordinance

- (a) Duty, the Town of Molitor shall place and maintain a copy of this Section at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Township.

Section VI. Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in ss. 30.80 are adopted by reference.

Section VII Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section VIII. Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
