BOATING ORDINANCE NO. 4

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING USE OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES ON CERTAIN WATERS.

The Town Board of the Town of Plum Lake, Vilas County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows: An Ordinance to prohibit the use of internal combustion engines for the propulsion of boats on certain public waters in the town of Plum Lake, Vilas County, Wisconsin, according to Wisconsin Statute 30.50 through 30.80 (1967) and in the interest of public health, safety and welfare.

Section 1 Definition of "Boat"

As used in this ordinance, "Boat" means every description of water craft, other than a seaplane on the water, used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water.

Section 2 Prohibited Operation:

No person shall operate a boat propelled by an internal combustion engine on any of the following public waters in the Town of Plum Lake., Vilas County,. Wisconsin:

Section 3: Penalties:

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.00 or imprisoned not more than 30 days, or both, for the first offense and fined not more than \$100.00 or imprisoned not more than 90 days, or both, upon conviction of the same offense or subsequent time within one year.

Section 4 Regulation:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after passage and posting as required by law and shall be enforced by any duly authorized officer of the Town of Plum Lake, County Officers, and Department of Natural Resources Officers.

Section 5 Severability:

The several terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable, and if any provisions of it or the application there—of to any person or circumstances held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected hereby.
