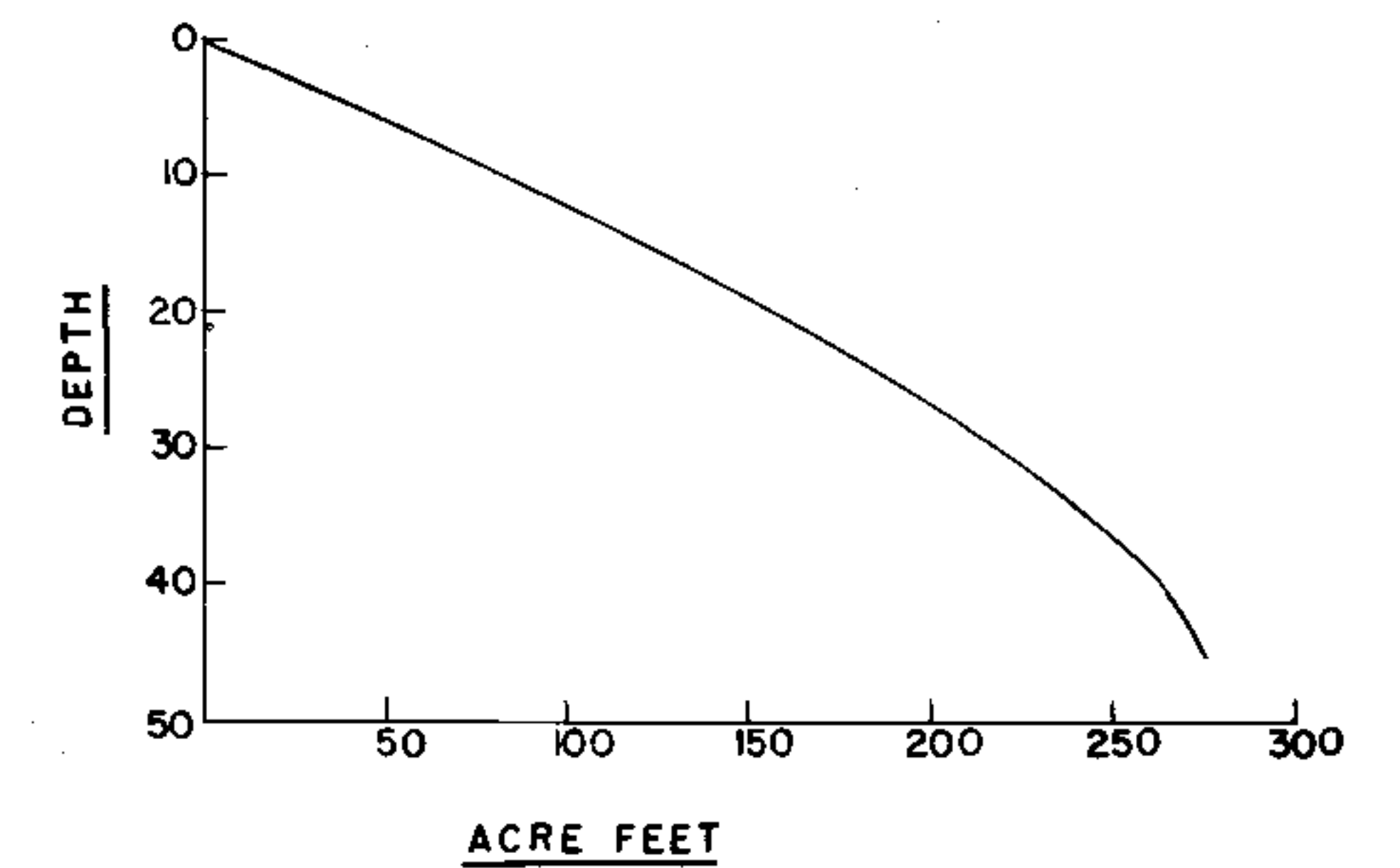


B.M. "X" Base of further most North East steel post at North end of Beach

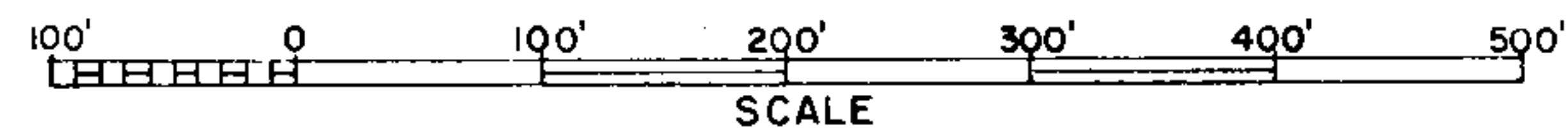
