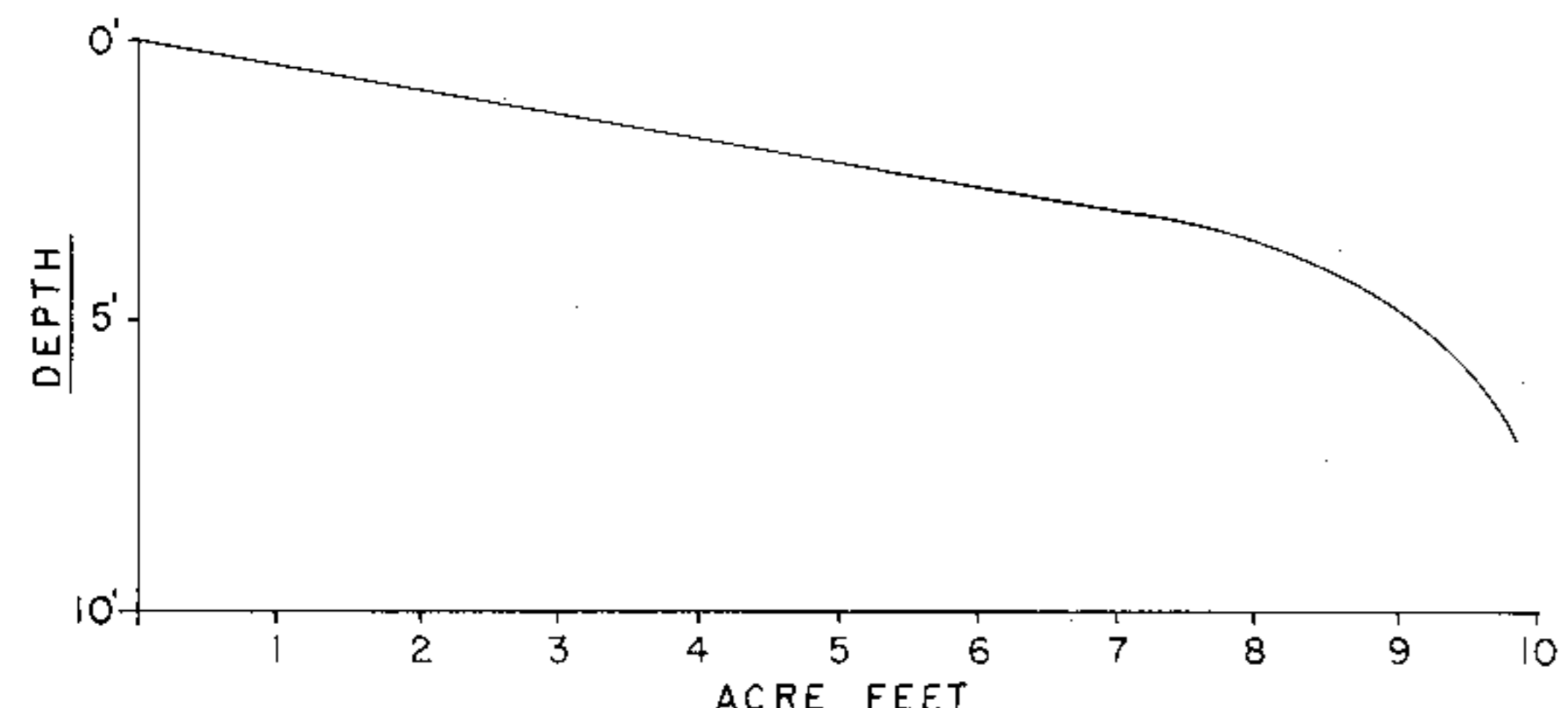


B.M. 'X' 2" "□" located on right side of dam.
