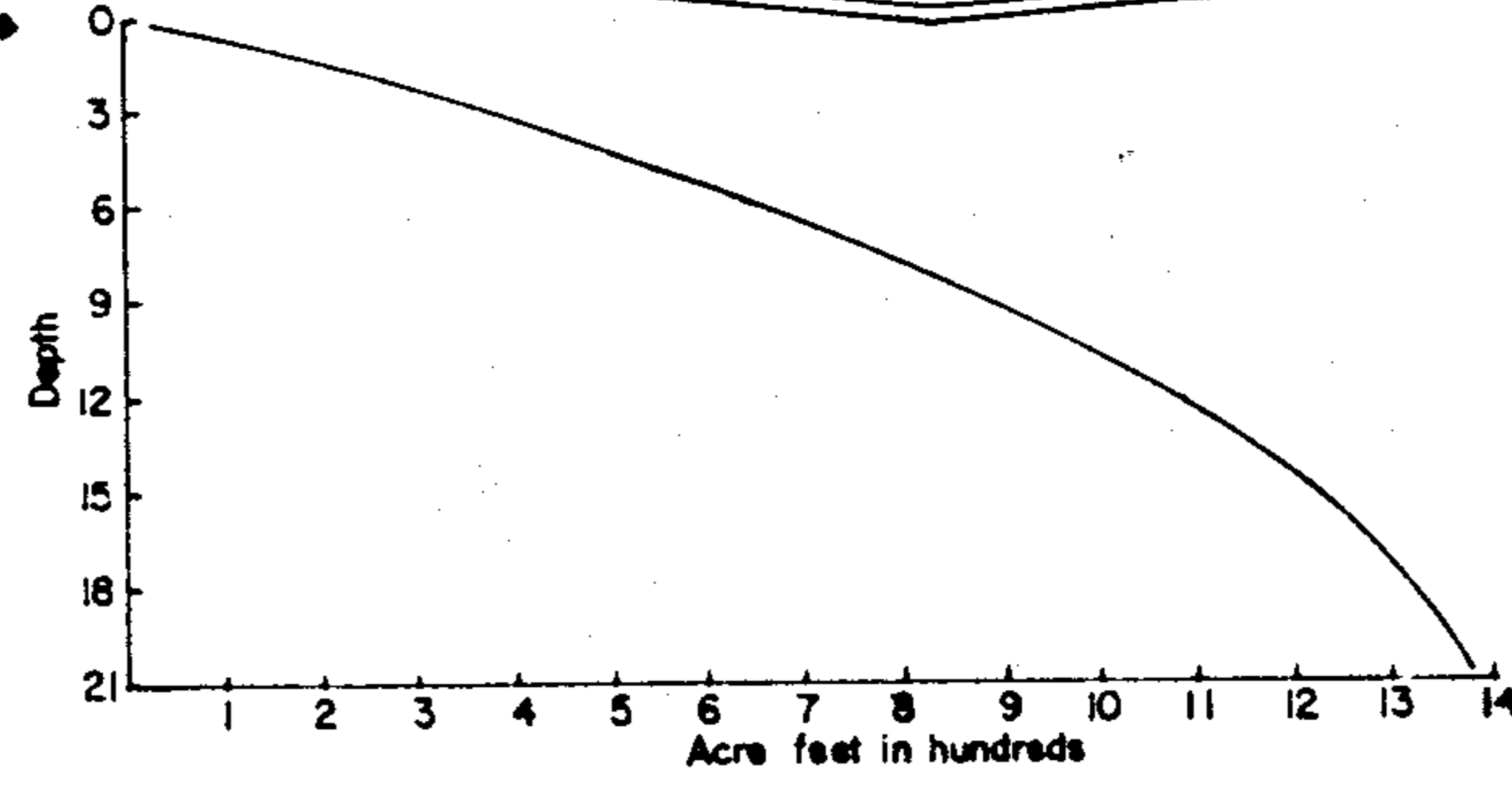


Bench mark (X) - top of town ordinance sign at public access on east side of lake.
