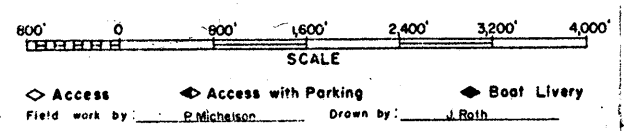


DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
