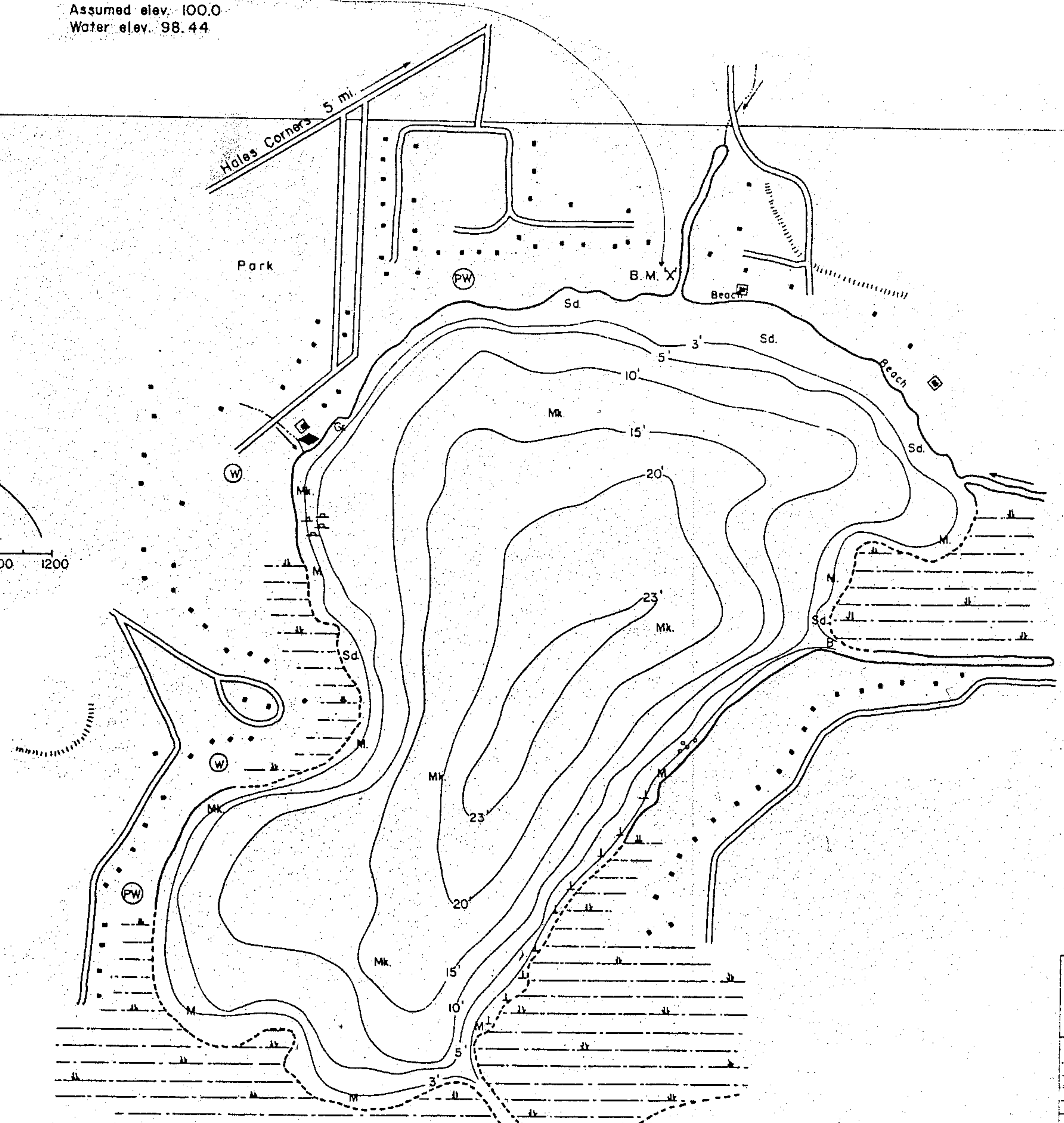
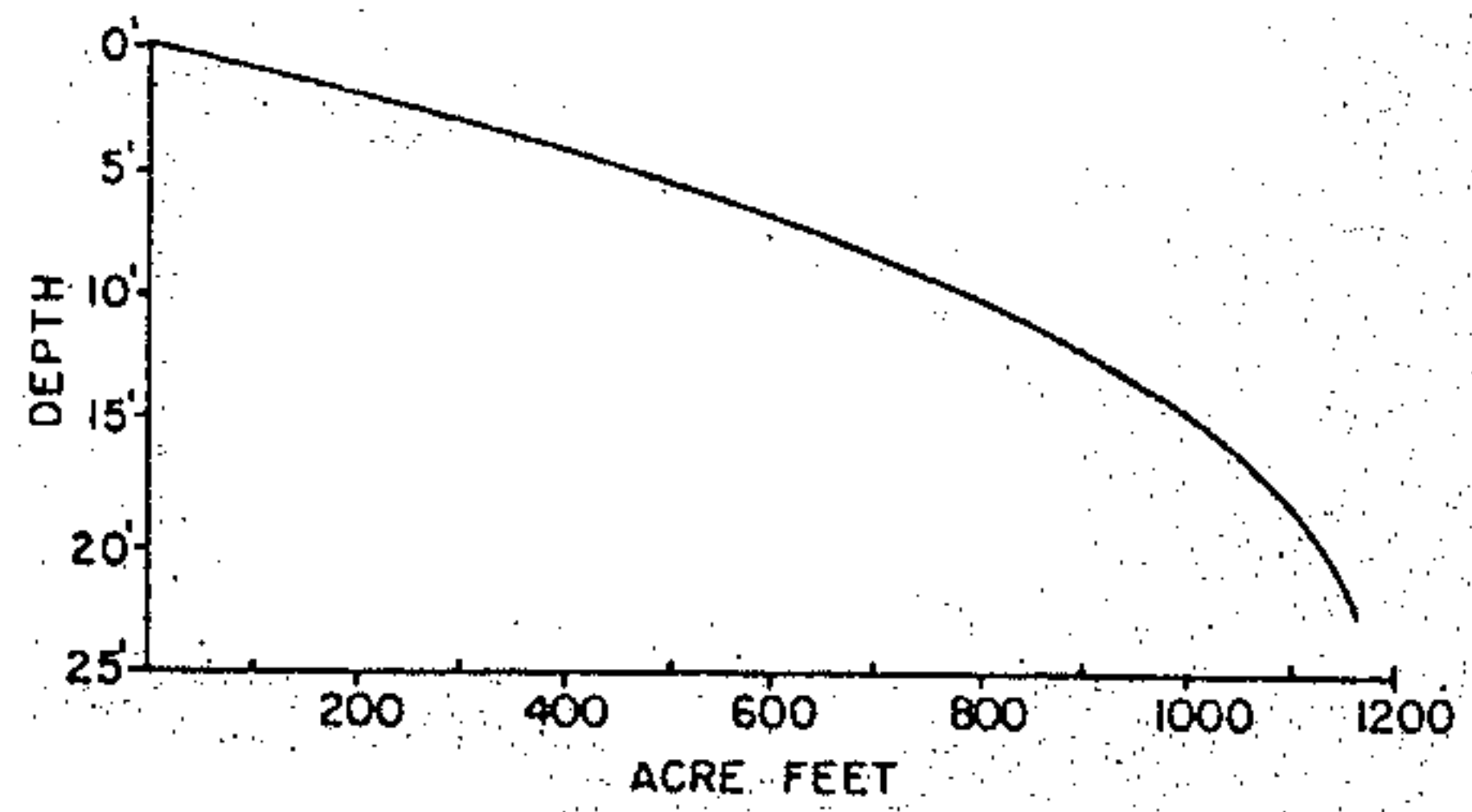


B.M. Cement retaining wall end, 30'

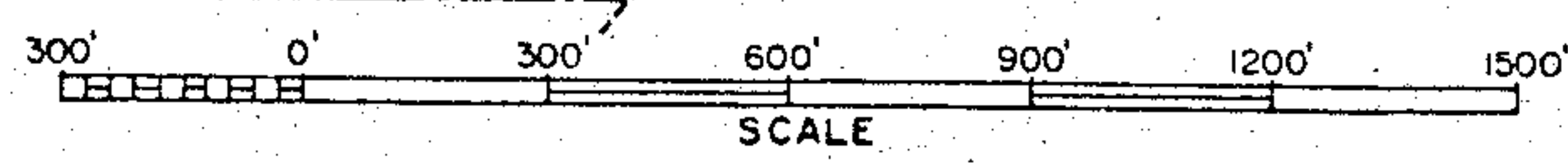
