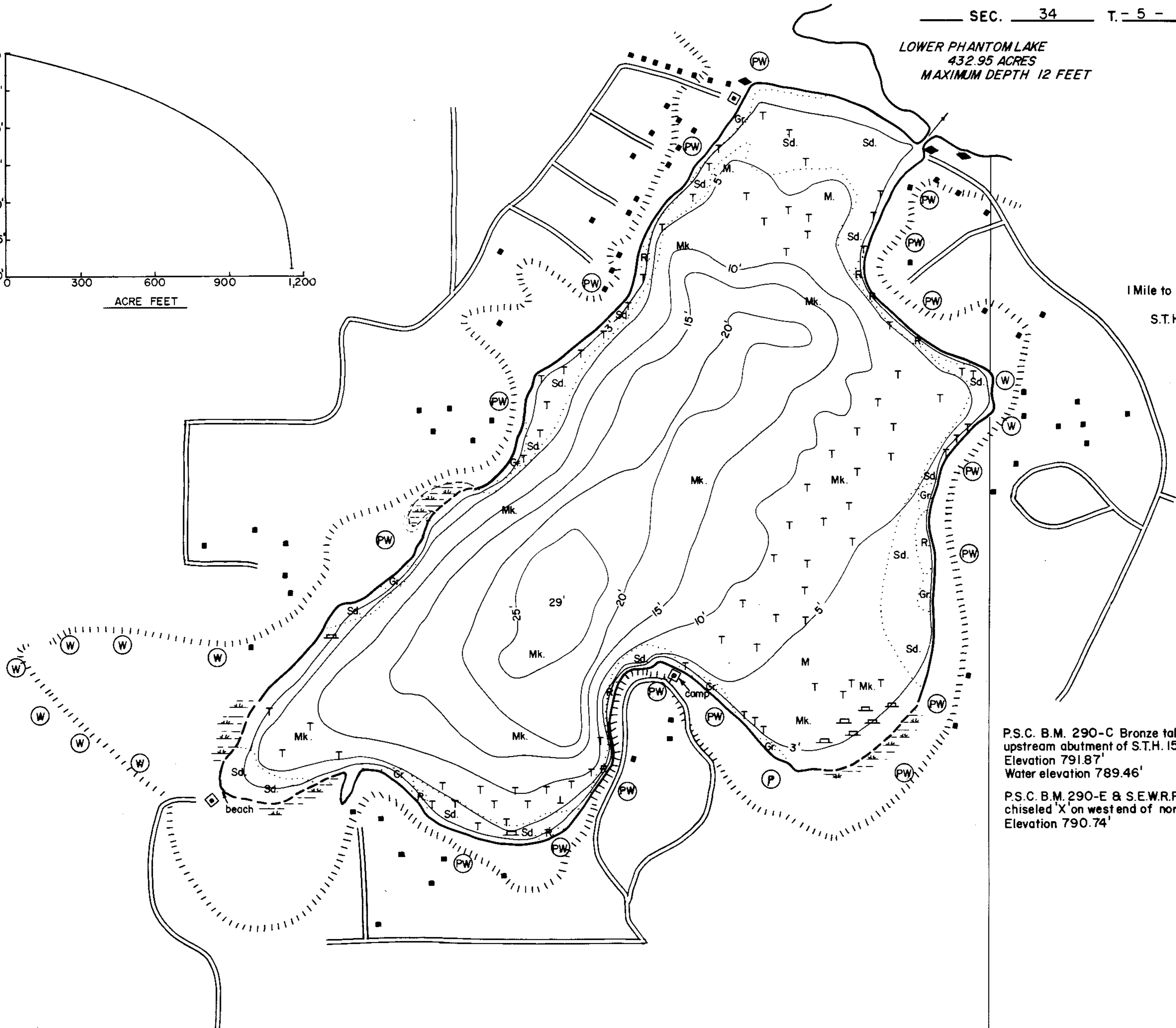
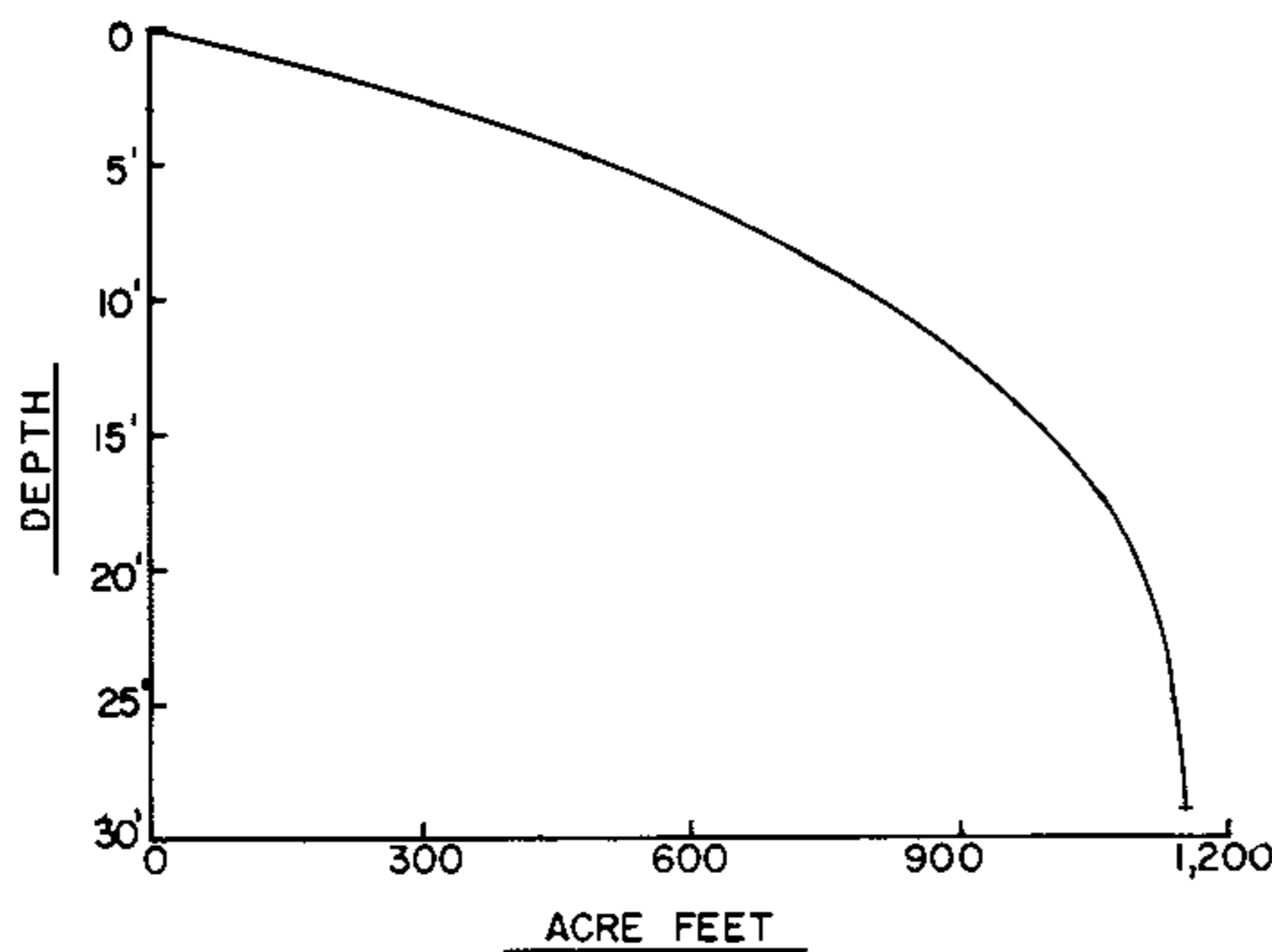


LOWER PHANTOM LAKE
