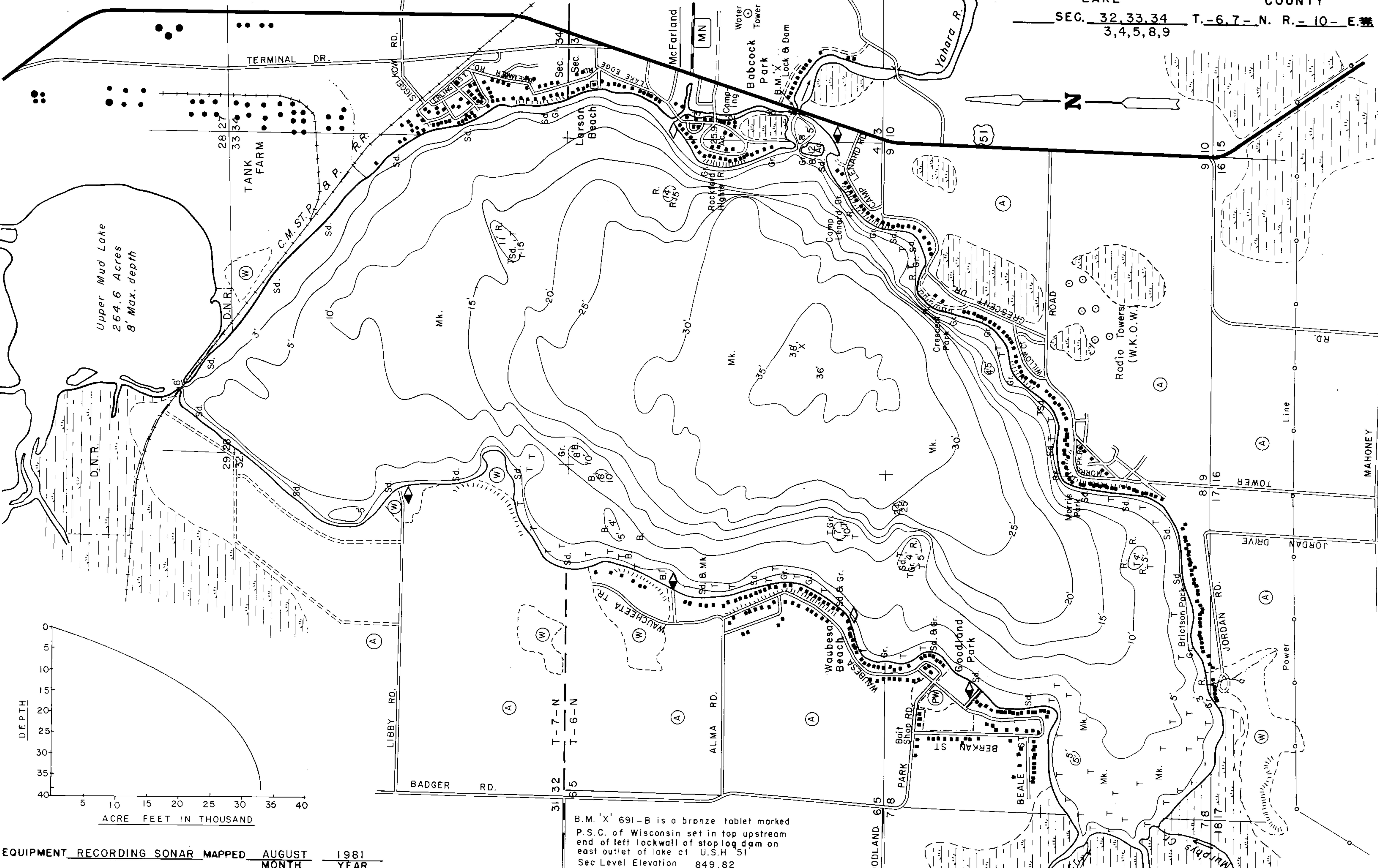
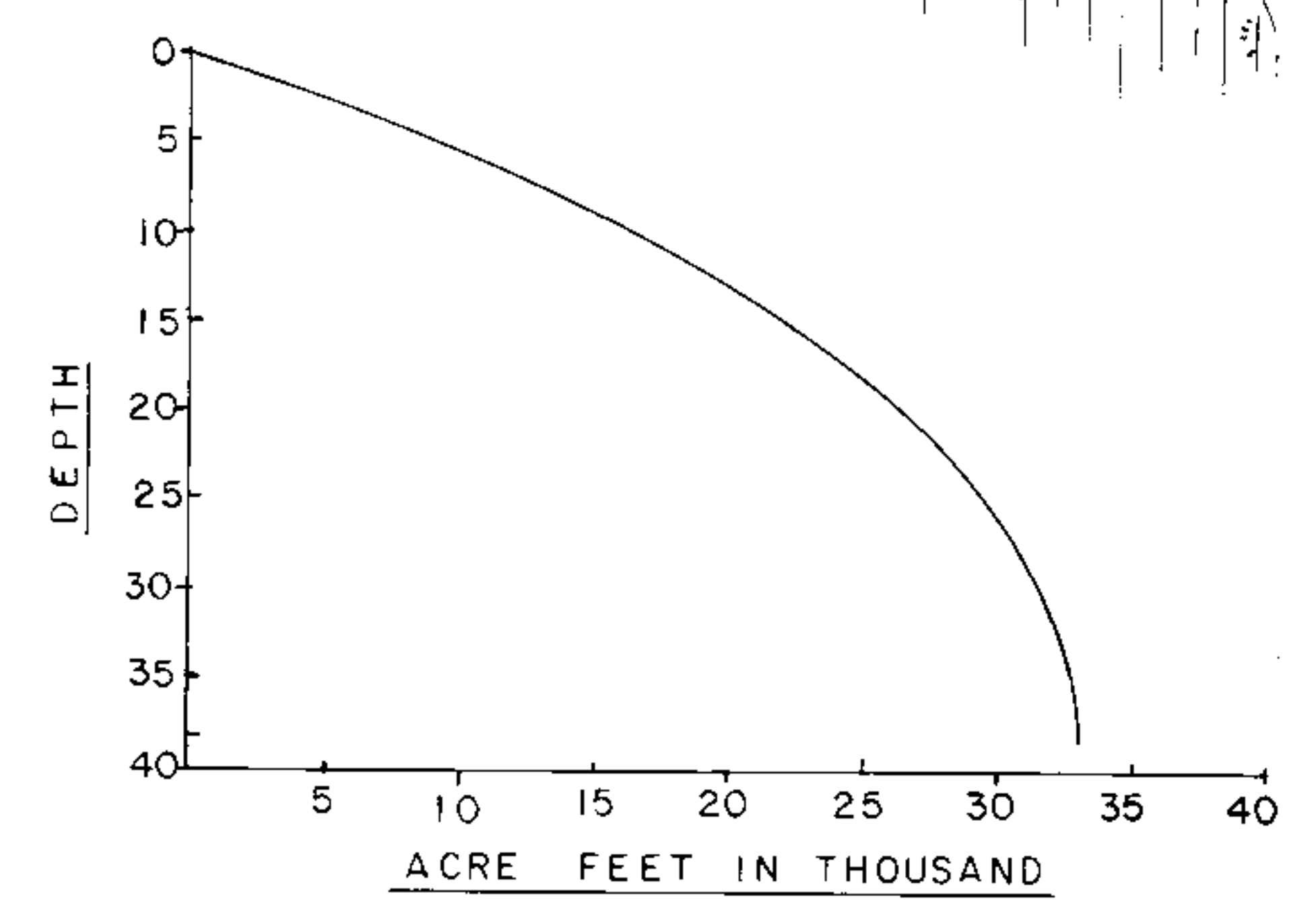


LAKE SURVEY MAP

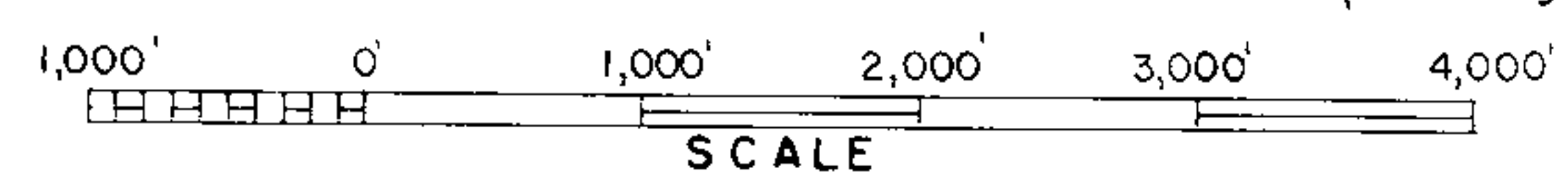


Upper Mud Lake
