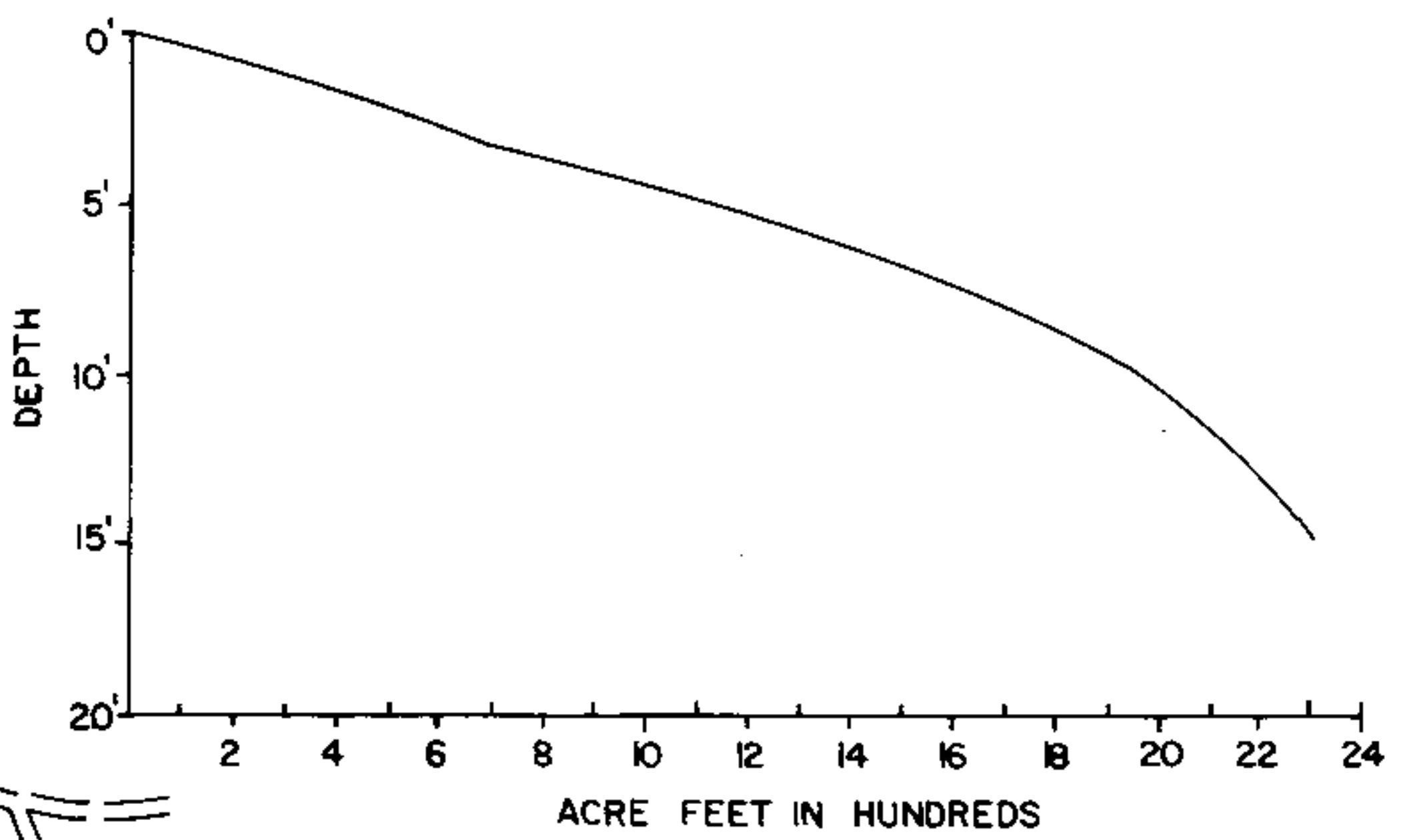


B.M. 'X' Highest point of 5.5' x 7' boulder 22' N. of N.W. corner of lakeside cement steps of cabin on S. shore of lake.
