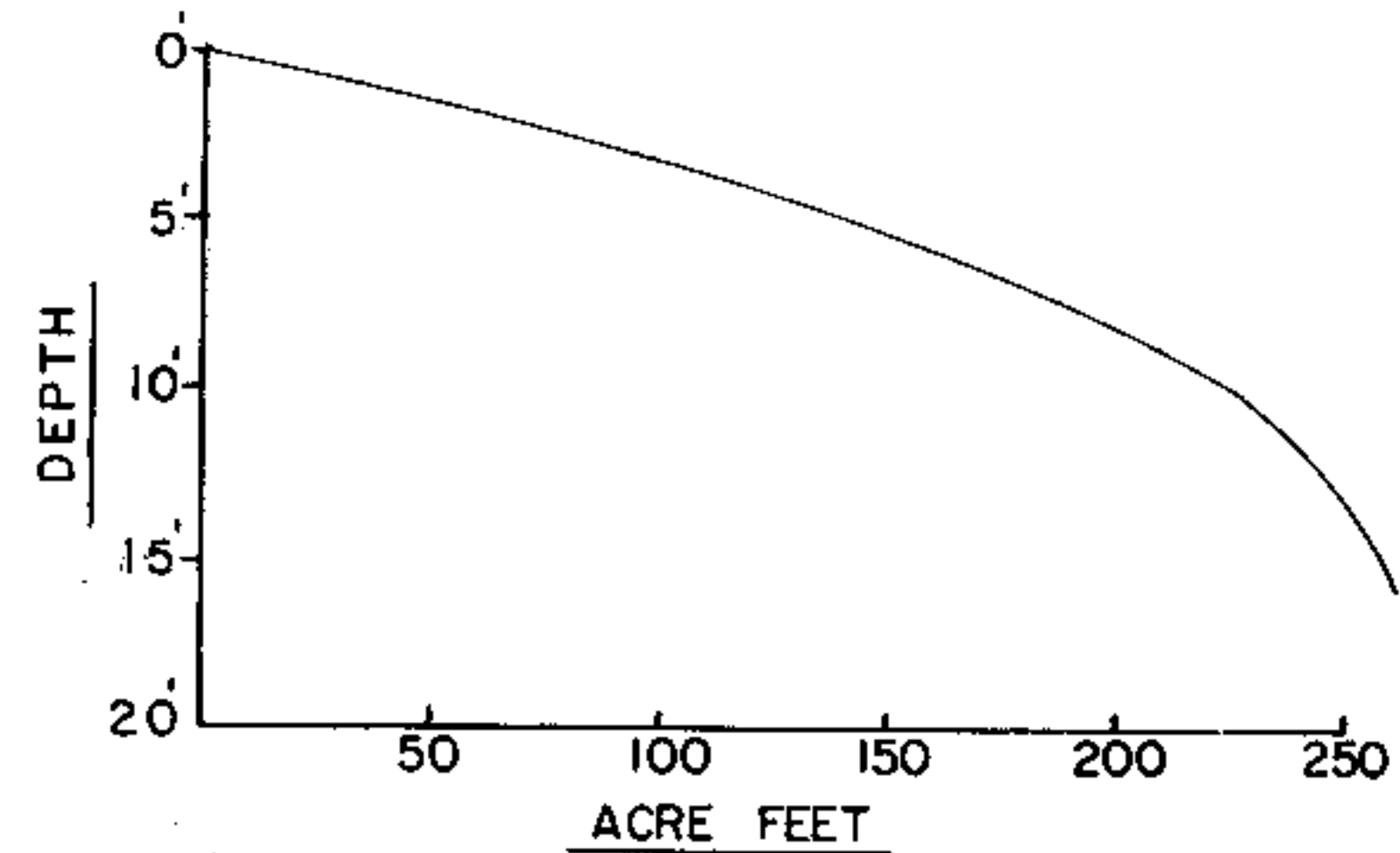


B.M.-X, No. 693-A, is a bronze tablet set in top of sandstone outcropping 136.5' upstream from dam on south bank of pond.
