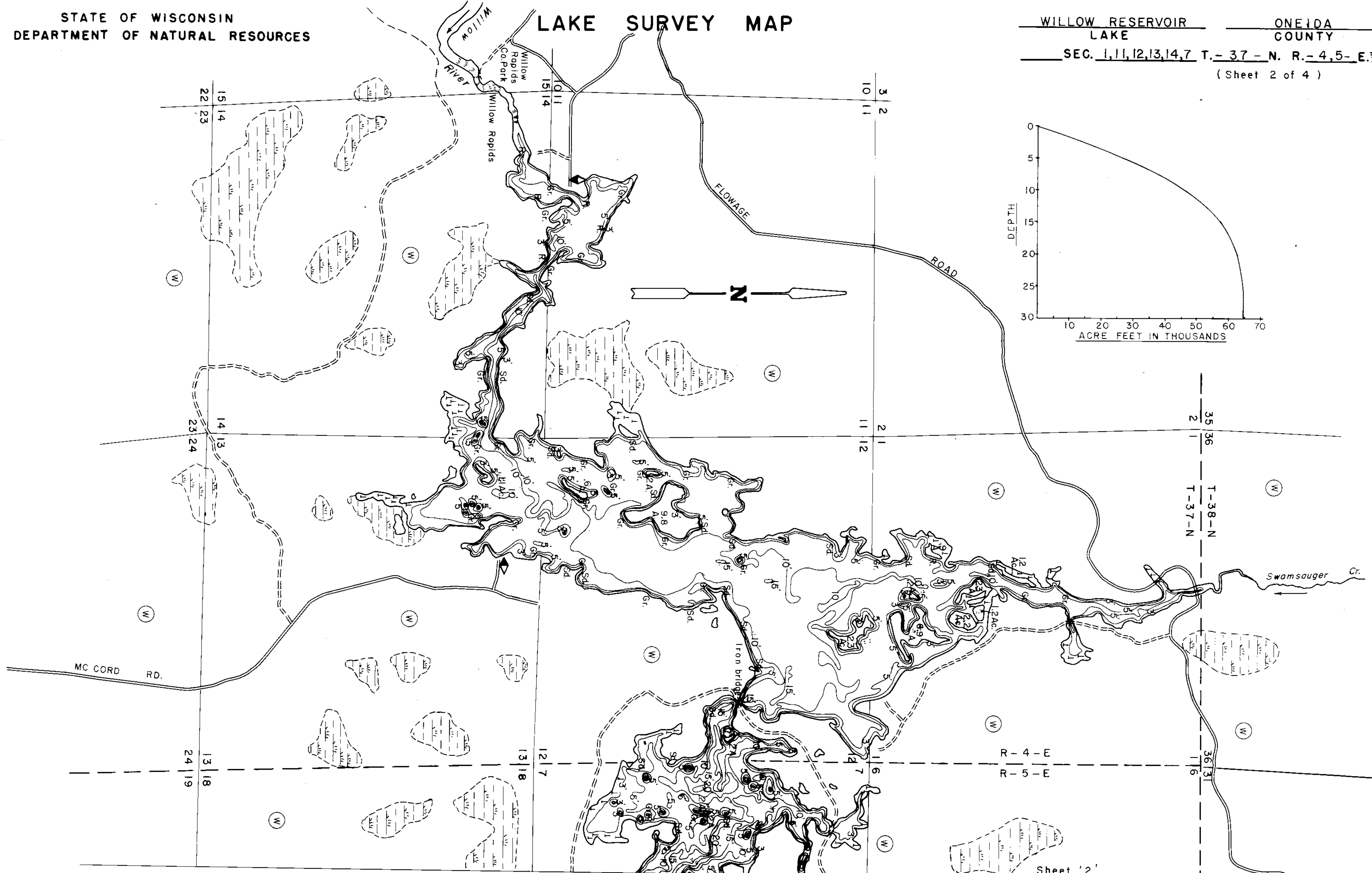

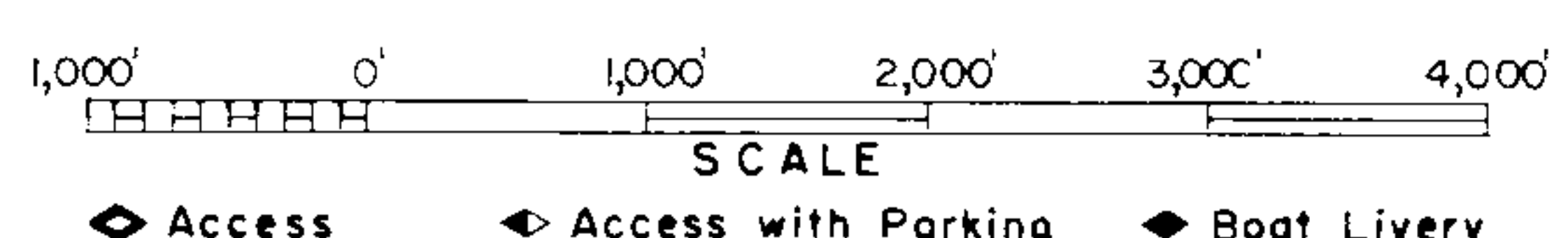
# LAKE SURVEY MAP

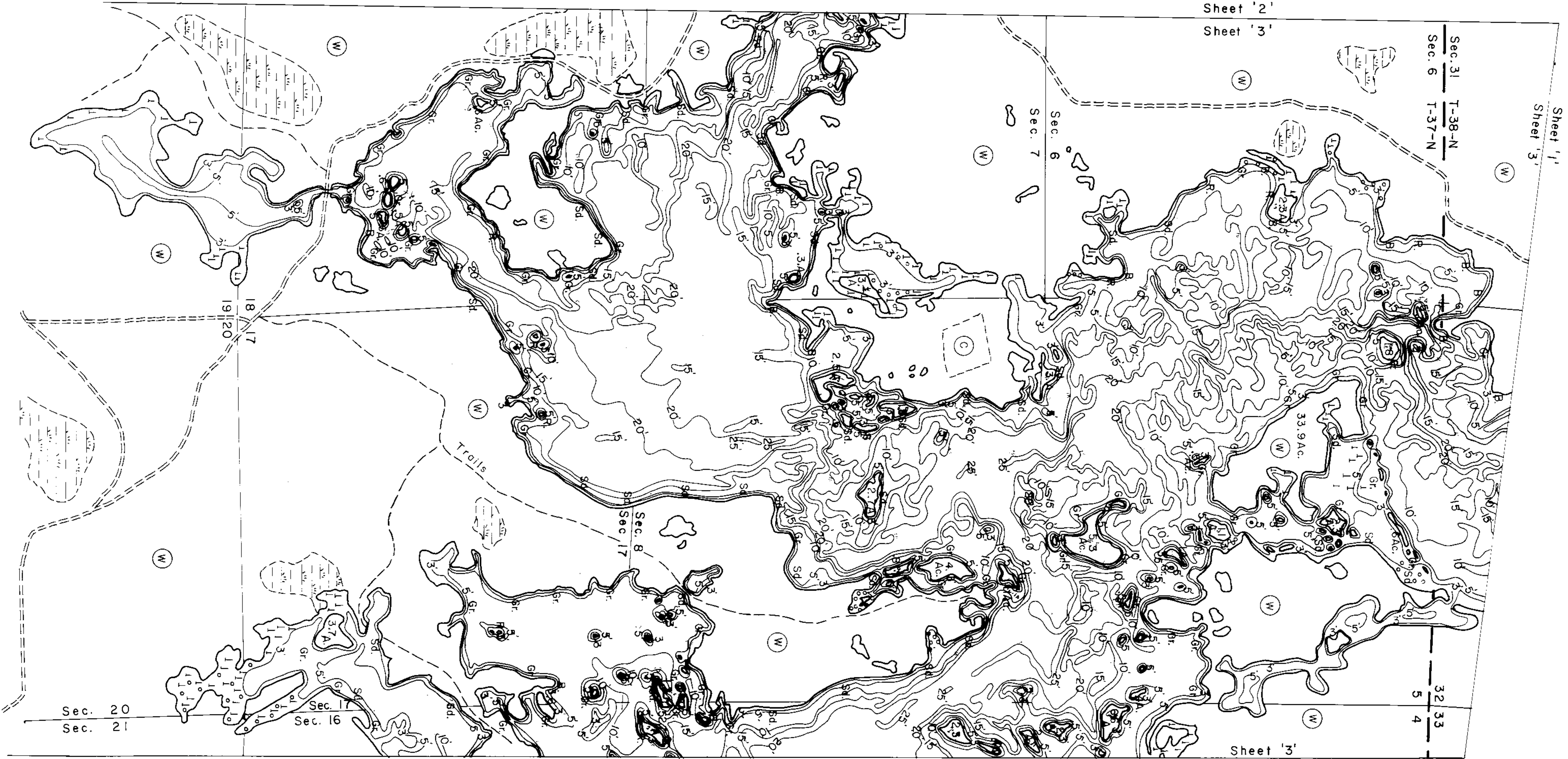

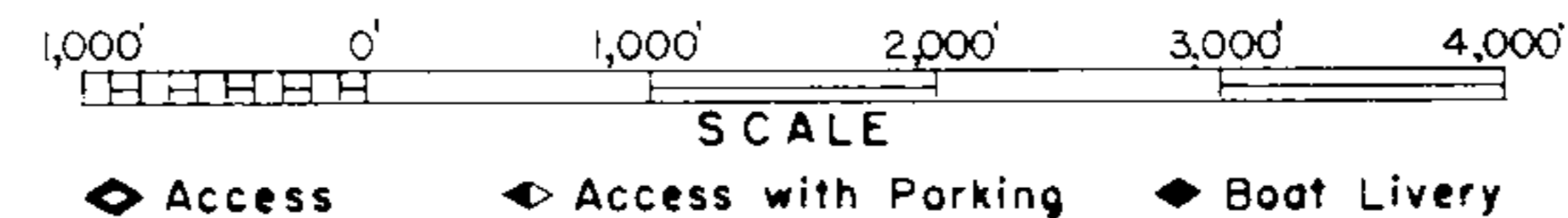

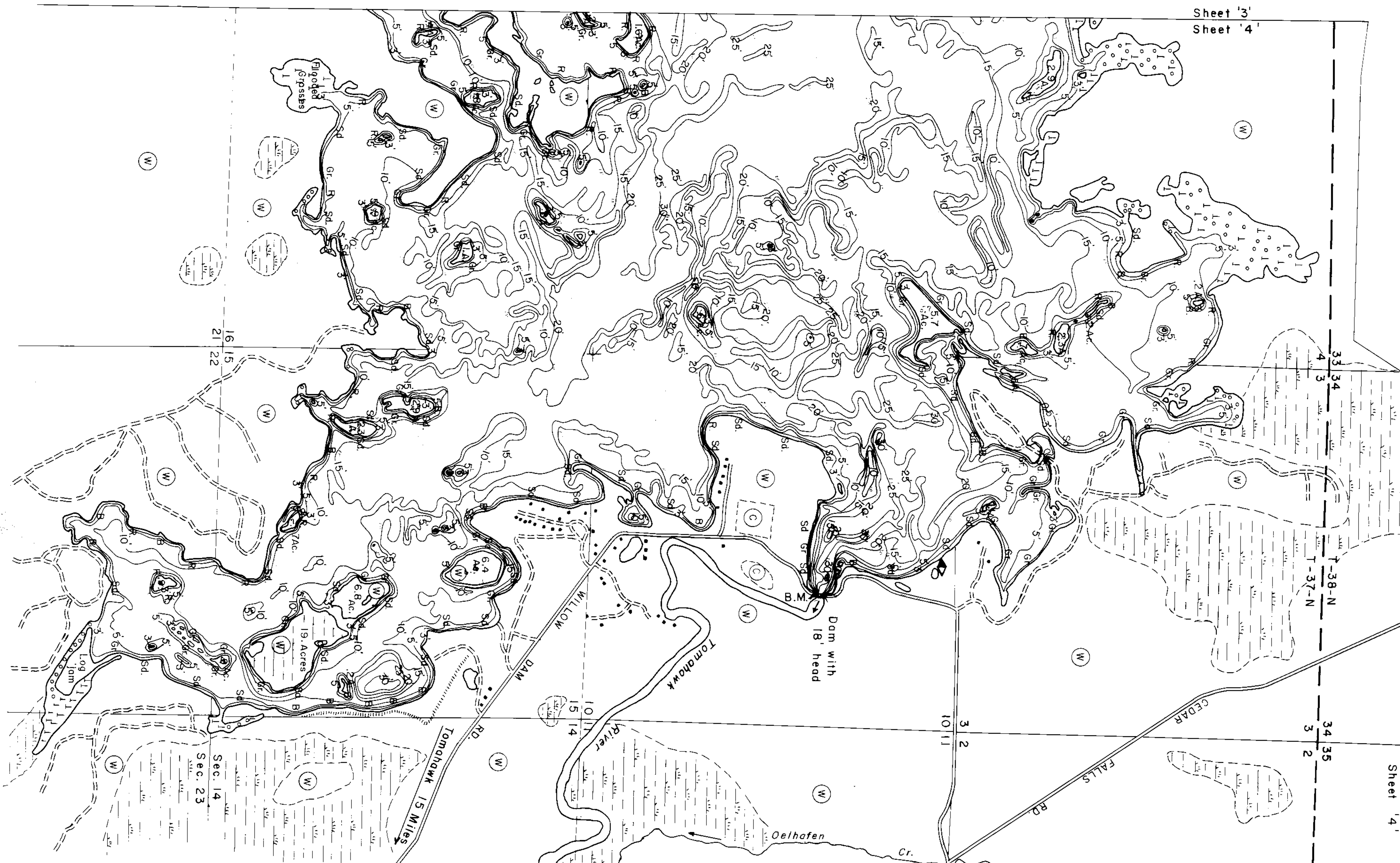
