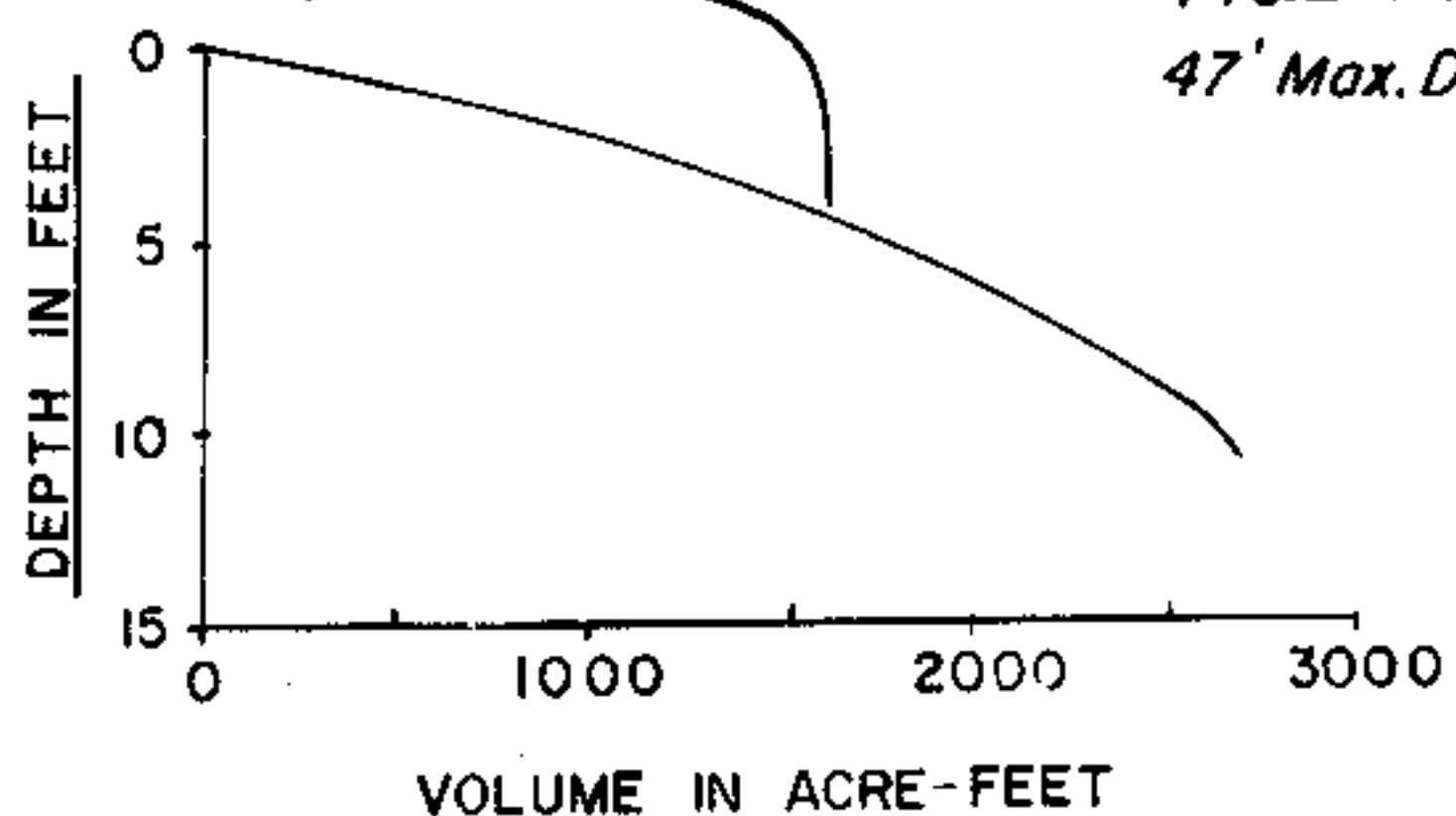
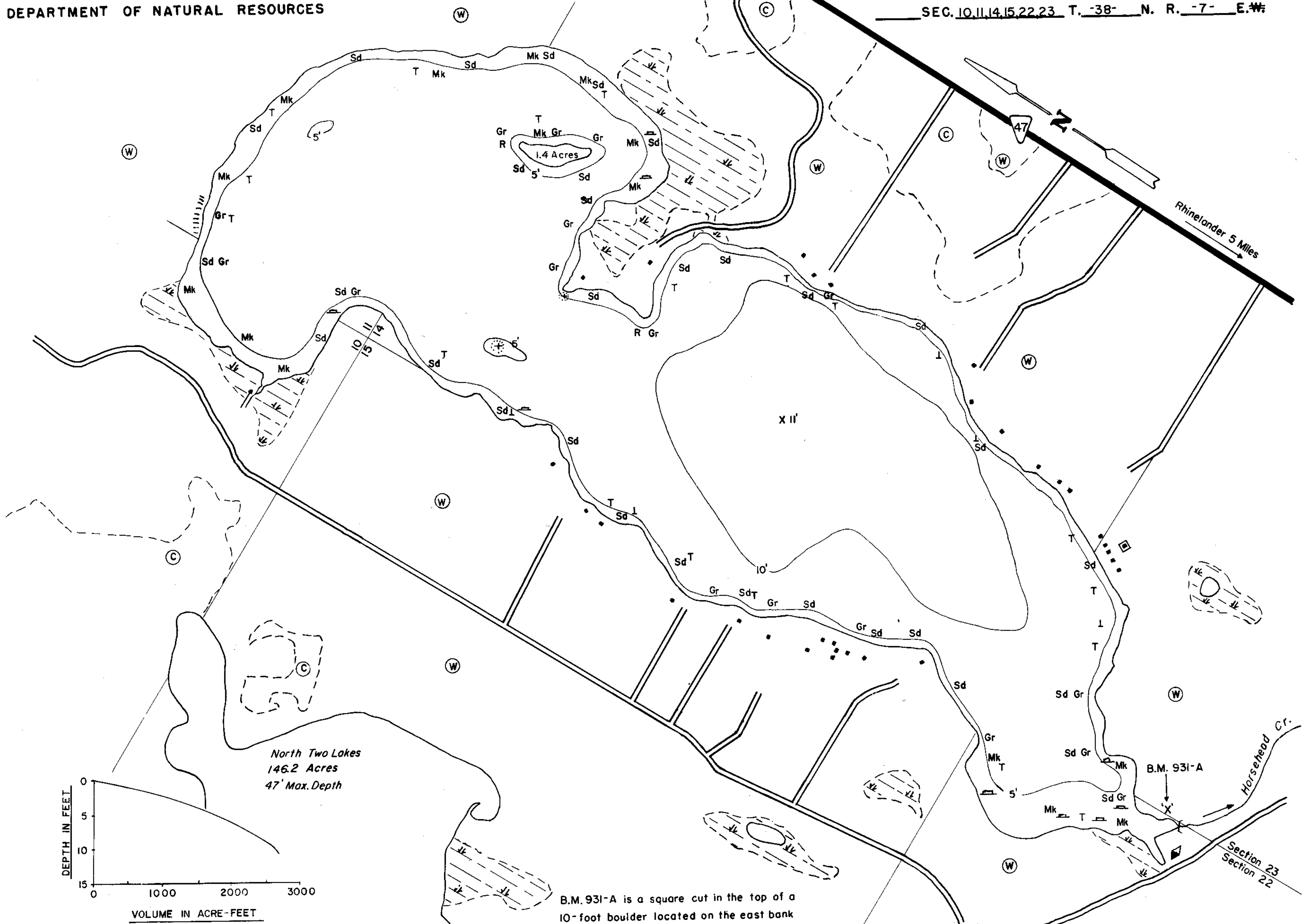


LAKE SURVEY MAP

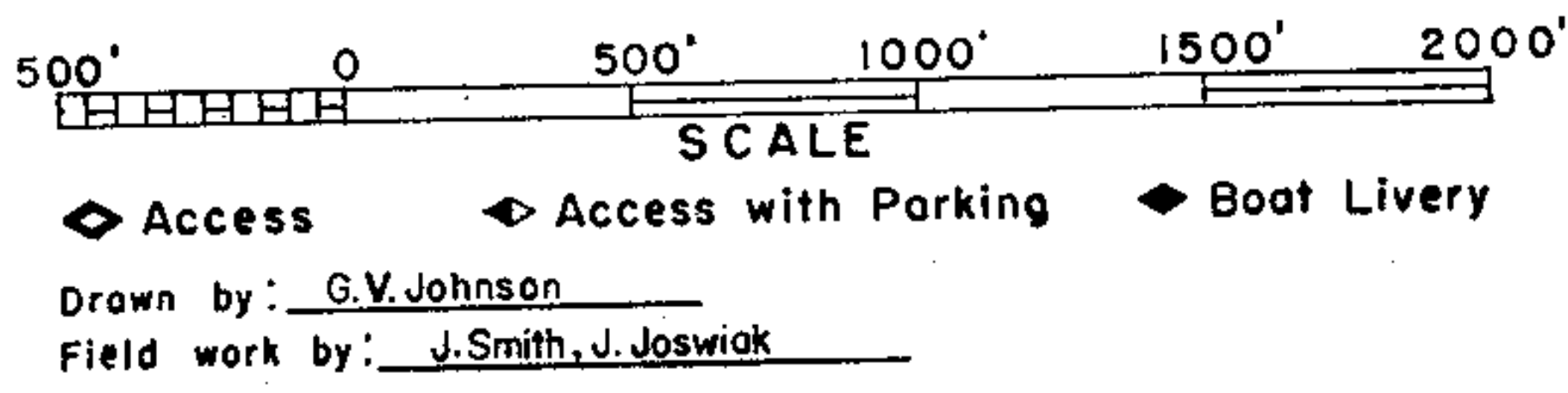
